Walter C. Kundinger, 85, of Akron and formerly of Kilmanagh, died Thursday morning, January 15, 2004, at the Bay Medical Care Facility in Essexville following a three-year illness. He was born April 21, 1918 in Kilmanagh, son of the late Otto and Alma (Thede) Kundinger.
