The Bountiful City Water Department is concerned about the critical lack of snow in our mountains this winter. Reports show we have only 8 inches of snow at the peak and are below the lowest point on record for this time of year. Additionally, the snowpack we have is already melting and the city's water treatment plant is seeing more than double the normal amount of runoff for this time of year. All are invited to pray for healthy water levels for our community.

Please place your **palms** from previous years in the basket in the church foyer to be burned for Ash Wednesday.

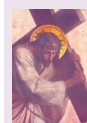
Palms will be burned *Monday, February 16* after the 6:00 PM Mass.
