1:30 PM: Plant Tour: Howard County Little Patuxent Water Reclamation Plant

The Little Patuxent Water Reclamation Plant, located in Savage, MD is permitted for 29 Million Gallon per Day (MGD) of Enhanced Nutrient Removal (ENR) treatment. It initially served only the town of Savage and beginning in 1964 was expanded and upgraded with eight major additions. The site has grown to over 35 acres and now serves the central part of Howard County, which contains 56% of the County's population. Improvements to the Biosolids Facilities are currently under construction. The tour will include an overview of the existing facilities, a look at some of the current project's new processes, and an initial "peak" at the solids drying facilities under construction. *Space is limited, so register early!*
