¹Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.

²And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*, to betray him;

³Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

⁴He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

⁵After that he poureth water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel wherewith he was girded.

⁶Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?

⁷Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter.

⁸Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.

⁹Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also *my* hands and *my* head.

¹⁰Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash *his* feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.

¹¹For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean.

¹²So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you?

¹³Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for *so* I am.

¹⁴If I then, *your* Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

¹⁵For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

¹⁶Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.

¹Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I would not have you ignorant. ²Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were led. ³Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and *that* no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. ⁴Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. ⁶And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. ⁷But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. ⁸For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; ⁹To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; ¹⁰To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another *divers* kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ¹¹But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. ¹²For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also *is* Christ. ¹³For by one Spirit are

we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

¹⁴For the body is not one member, but many. ¹⁵If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? ¹⁶And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? ¹⁷If the whole body *were* an eye, where *were* the hearing? If the whole *were* hearing, where *were* the smelling? ¹⁸But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him. ¹⁹And if they were all one member, where *were* the body? ²⁰But now *are they* many members, yet but one body. ²¹And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you. ²²Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary: ²³And those *members* of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely *parts* have more abundant comeliness. ²⁴For our comely *parts* have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that *part* which lacked: ²⁵That there should be no schism in the body; but *that* the members should have the same care one for another. ²⁶And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it. ²⁷Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. ²⁸And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. ²⁹*Are* all apostles? *are* all prophets? *are* all teachers? *are* all workers of miracles? ³⁰Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret? ³¹But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet show I unto you a more excellent way.

1 Corinthians 13:1-3

¹Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become *as* sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

²And though I have *the gift of* prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

³And though I bestow all my goods to feed *the poor*, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

⁴Charity suffereth long, *and* is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

⁵Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

⁶Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

⁷Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

⁸Charity never faileth: but whether *there be* prophecies, they shall fail; whether *there be* tongues, they shall cease; whether *there be* knowledge, it shall vanish away.

⁹For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.

¹⁰But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.

¹¹When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

¹²For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

¹³And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these *is* charity.

1 Corinthians 14:1-5

¹Follow after charity, and desire spiritual *gifts*, but rather that ye may prophesy.

²For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth *him*; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

³But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men *to* edification, and exhortation, and comfort.

⁴He that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

⁵I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater *is* he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.

1 Corinthians 14:12

¹³Wherefore let him that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue pray that he may interpret. ¹⁴For if I pray in an *unknown* tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.

Serving others in the church has had its rewards. As a servant without any motives to climb the ladder, make money or making a name for myself, my mindsets were molded for kingdom work. Watching, praying, serving, and praising the Lord. Watching, praying, serving, and praising the Lord. Watching, praying, serving, and praising the Lord. That was my life after I started attending church services.

The presence of God and His favor has increased in my life. Souls are being saved and lives are being transformed for God's glory. God deserves all the honor and glory for the things that we do in our ministry. It was through God's Holy Bible that I can hear His voice. I was mentored by the Holy Spirit along with different people who helped me to grow in the things of the Lord mentoring or being the pastoral covering over me.

Now using the word of God I can teach, impart, and enjoy God's gifts as a leader.

We dedicated our ministries to the Lord and are moving towards the goal of having multiple ministries for God. One of the hardest parts in ministry for me is to see that there are not very many people who take purity and abstinence seriously.

Where are the people who will give a purity commitment to the Lord – to live righteously? Where are the single people who will give God their time? Where are the married people who will give God their time? Where are the people who will lay down their own agendas to further the work for the Lord? Why is it so hard for people to let go of the old mindsets that misused grace to drink alcohol, do drugs, fornicate, divorce, and live a sinful life? Living a life of sinfulness is never rewarded by God why is it rewarded by man who perishes?

Living a life of grace and repentance is always honored by God. Living a life of purity, holiness, gentleness and kindness is a beautiful way to live your life before man and before the Lord.

The Lord has blessed us because of purity why would I want to bring anyone to the next level who doesn't want to live or walk in purity and holiness. Purity and holiness doesn't mean that we have to be perfect. In fact, the Lord told me after He asked me to start using the title of apostle, **"It is okay for you to make mistakes."** If it is okay for me to make mistakes, then it is okay for others around me to make mistakes. Willful sinful disobedience is not a mistake.

This morning as I was reading one of my Bibles I came past a note that had the date of June 9, 2011 written by it. That was the morning an angel came into my bedroom and tucked a supernatural sheet above my breasts and put a supernatural purity ring on my left hand's ring finger.

As God's has given me specific dates for different things in my life I have had many of them written down and notarized in a book. Some of the special dates include:

February 23, 2011 – God asked me to start using the title of apostle. His exact words were **"I would like you to start using the title of apostle."**;

February 24, 2011 – God spoke to me and said **"And, you can fly first class."** That is what God thought of me when very few others even cared enough to call, visit, or sit next to me (or allow me to sit next to them in prayer meetings);

June 9, 2011 – As I was waking up an angel was in my bedroom pulling a supernatural sheet up above my breasts and put a supernatural purity ring on my left ring finger;

July 21, 2011 – On this day, my Father's birthday, the Lord spoke to me and told me **"You have the gift of miracles."**;

Obtained ministry licensing 2012;

October 12, 2013 – Ordained in ministry on my mother’s birthday;

February 22, 2015 – God showed me in an open *vision* my general’s uniform on the morning prior to being invited by another ministry to join them because they said God was calling the general’s of the Twin Cities together for a meeting; and

February 23, 2015 – After leaving the meeting for General’s in the Twin Cities which I had been invited to the Lord reminded me as I was driving that it was my 4th year anniversary from when He had asked me to use the title of apostle.

Persecution and vengeance from the church has been my roughest battle before the Lord but He blesses me when His children do not live according to His plan and His desires. He gives me stars and stripes for my general’s uniform and he showed me that in an open *vision*.

As a seer God has honored me when others disrespect me. He shows me dreams and visions of what He sees. Do you know how many times God has shown me in a dream or *vision* someone looking down on me? Do you know how many times God has shown a person’s backside to me where they are bent over (not being upright in God’s sight) being an ass to me in a *vision* is what God sees and thinks they are behaving like.

Bringing reformation to the church I use the title of apostle. Many people are still in the old formations of dishonoring who God has promoted to lead and teach His people. Many times they try to strip the title of apostle from me but I know who I am in Christ. I know who I am created to be. I am one of God’s generals; I am one of God’s servants. God recently reminded me to use the bible verse: that His gifts and call are irrevocable and cannot be withdrawn as mentioned in Romans 11:29.

In 1997, God whispered the words **“I love you”** into my right ear and it tingled for days. That was after I entered the church for the long-haul in 1997 just after a three-year marriage ended.

More recently God spoke sweetly to me saying **“I created you so that I would have someone to love.”**

God’s word says my sheep hear my voice and they follow me. I follow the teachings set before us in the Holy Bible as I follow our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

In 2011, God spoke to me saying **“I have given you credit for starting the church in Delray Beach, Florida.”** That church was started because of revival meetings where I was a ministry leader for revival meetings where we had about 1,200 people from the Haitian communities coming to meetings every night. The testimonies from people laying down their voodoo altars repenting came forward. People were being delivered from witchcraft and sinful lifestyles. Some of the evil practices were sending curses upon me as the voodoo priests sat in the doorway of the church while I was just a few feet away behind a counter. People had to stop giving their money to voodoo priests because they were repenting before the Lord and they got angry with us.

After 60 days I returned to Minnesota bruised and worn down because of a leadership team who didn’t value me having an excellent spirit. As I knelt down at my bed where I was staying before an evening meeting I wept before the Lord and He spoke to me saying **“They have rejected the spirit of excellence that I have put inside of you.”** Just before leaving this ministry I scheduled the local community pool for the first sessions of baptism and prepared the databases and baptismal certificate documents where I believe over 300 people were baptized. I was also able to prepare and serve communion for people who were not allowed to have communion with the Lord at their home churches.

As a retired construction worker, now ministry leader, I minister through our TV station, website and online ministries, books and bible studies, conferences, recovery groups, prayer groups and street ministry.

This is revival. I have been in revival for many years having been brought to the front to do a great work for the Lord because man could not find a reason to tear me down on the stand in a court room where I had

brought a claim against a contractor for damaging my home after I paid him \$37,671.17. I went to church with this brother for 4 years and went on 2 construction missions trips where he was the leader. Who could have I trusted with my home's updating if I couldn't trust someone I went to church with?

My own attorney was diagnosed with cancer after they wrongfully kicked my case out of court, and he died a year after lying to the MN appeals court judges telling them an outright lie. He didn't know that I was in the courtroom when he faced 3 appeals court judges saying "Her home was foreclosed on and she no longer lives in it." I still live in the home which had never been foreclosed on. After the hearing I asked my own attorney "What were you thinking when you told them my home was foreclosed upon?" and he said "It sounded good!" to which I replied, "It didn't sound good to me."

My own attorney betrayed me to further his own agenda and to help 17 other cited entities including the county judge – the state of Minnesota – and the defendants whose insurance agents were referenced in dishonesty as part of the corruption complaint. When I heard that he had died I took his death hard because the wrongs which were never repented of. The system mocked and laughed at me when they refused to investigate their own judges, attorneys, rules and regulations. I brought a 1700 page corruption complaint to our governmental authorities and then God asked me to start using the title of apostle. In my sleep I had heard myself screaming as someone was going to hell and I believe that it was my former Jewish attorney. I took his death hard because I don't want anyone to perish, not even my enemies.

Injustice after injustice, bruise after bruise, taking the beatings from God's people I have made it to the point to where I am because of God's supernatural power to heal and restore me. Jesus wept. I have wept.

God is a supernatural God! He came into my bedroom and sent His power into my right arm and through my breast and showed me through healing classes and the medical research – the connection – between abortion and some breast cancers. God supernaturally healed

me of undiagnosed breast cancer and it was confirmed at a well-known evangelists healing meeting back in the 90's.

As a revivalist I focus on winning the lost to Christ. What more could I possibly do to love Jesus Christ in return? What more could I do to lay my life down for a friend or relative who may not make it to heaven because they are living a lifestyle of sin.

“Love isn't always nice” are the words from a man during healing school when I was in class to learn how to pray for people. The man actually wrote those words on a note because of someone who had tried to destroy my reputation. I was encouraged by a pastor at healing school to hold a contractor and another apostle accountable in the courts. Just after that encouragement the Lord spoke to me and said **“Seek me privately.”** I left that church and started holding the people accountable in the courts as I was directed to do by the church staff. Then, I prepared the documentation for the corruption case as the Holy Spirit led me to do. That affidavit is called “Plaintiff Wept” and is just one of several affidavits I have prepared for future use.

January 27, 2011 I made a decision to go off prescription drugs which the medical community required me to take after I came off the weight-loss drugs called phen-fen which damaged the pineal gland in my brain. I now have an affidavit showing the process and link to the drugs which I thought would have been safe for me to use. I felt like I was a guinea pig testing drugs so a doctor could make a name for himself.

Reminding the government of the harmful affects of phen-fen and reminding the prescribing doctors of the dangerous side affects of the medications they were prescribing seems meaningless because they have not done anything to my knowledge to change their practices to truly help people become healthy.

I have been free from the harmful prescription medications for over 5 years which had been required by the medical community for 15 years. I know the healer now. God is my healer – to God be the glory – I am very thankful.

Several years ago I saw in an open *vision* the Holy Spirit dove fly up into the sky after a grave-side burial service of one of my mentor pastors. I was a bit grieved to see that there wasn't an obituary in the paper and a bit grieved to see that there wasn't a normal funeral service. This pastor mentor had many friends and meant a lot to many people who were not able to be at her funeral to honor the home-going of one of God's saints.

I took her death hard because she had not fulfilled all that she wanted to do. Just several months before she passed away she wanted me to help her write 5 fresh new books with her testimonies of miracles which God had done. I couldn't do both her writing and what God was asking me to do. She had passed away about 3 months after the last prophetic word she gave to me from the Lord. She said **"Delicate treasure, like a diamond."**

Then, one week after Pastor Jeanette's burial God filled my bedroom while I was sleeping with the eternal love, joy and peace as heaven came to earth. I was having an open *vision* – heavenly encounter – with the Lord and was giggling as the Holy Spirit rolled me over in my bed as Jesus passed through my ceiling walking on a plane which was about 1 foot lower than the ceiling in my bedroom. Walking on the right side of Jesus Christ was a woman and although I did not see her face I believe it was the pastor who I served in ministry who many in the church and her family rejected. As a seer God showed me that the bottom of this woman's wedding dress was pure white. Heaven came to earth that day and I have been able to minister using the demonstrations of the eternal love, joy and peace that is truly hard to explain.

The robes and crowns we receive in heaven can be really, really, really out of this world too. A robe and crown which my sister who has Down's syndrome will receive when she goes to heaven is pure white, the robe having pure gold down the front and the smooth rounded globe type crown having pure gold in stripes down from the golden knob point on the top of the crown.

Laying down worldly agenda's and serving the Lord is all worth it. To God be the glory for helping me overcome many difficult obstacles, to God be the glory for His creation, and to God be the glory for you.

Chapter 30

Suicide Prevention

Suicide Prevention 1: Sometimes medications cause suicidal thoughts. This is why it is good to have good Biblical counseling, to eat healthy, and to get proper rest.

Suicide Prevention 2: The spirit behind suicide is never God.

Suicide Prevention 3: Be good to people because you never know what they are going through.

Suicide Prevention 4: Many people perish for lack of knowledge. A pastor once shared in Bible study that God told him if he would commit suicide that the pastor would go to hell.

Suicide Prevention 5: The devil (Satan) is at the root of suicide because he hates God and God's people.

Suicide Prevention 6: The devil tried to get Jesus to commit suicide but Jesus overcame the attack of the enemy (Luke 4:9-13).

Suicide Prevention 7: Satan's attempt against Jesus:

And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season (Luke 4:9-13).

Suicide Prevention 8: Overcome with the word of God:

I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one (1 John 2:14).

Suicide Prevention 9:

Speak the Word of God out loud:

I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord (Psalm 118:17).

Suicide Prevention 10:

Pray to God using the prayer Psalm 118:17 and say, I forgive those that have hurt me, those that offended me, and I forgive you God. Please forgive my sins and help me live right.

Suicide Prevention 11:

Forgive: Let go of bitterness, anger, and unforgiveness. If people don't forgive they will perish and go to hell for eternity. It says so in Hosea 4:6 & Matthew 6:14-15.

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children (Hosea 4:6).

For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: but if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses (Matthew 6:14-15).

Suicide Prevention 12:

Repent: Get help if you struggle with thoughts of ending your life. God is the creator of life and loves you.

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is long suffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9)

Suicide Prevention 13:

Live right so you can die right. Life is precious!

Suicide Prevention 14:

Eat healthy, reduce your stress levels, stop drinking alcohol, smoking, and doing drugs, get light exercise, close the doors which keep you oppressed, get Biblical counseling, and if necessary check yourself into the emergency room at the hospital until you can overcome suicidal thoughts.

Memorize: Re-read and memorize some of the scriptures in this chapter so that if you or someone that you know is struggling with suicidal thoughts you can say them out loud to yourself or to them and encourage them to live life and be healthy.

Statement of Faith:

Salvation through confession of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. (Acts 4:12; Romans 10:9-10; John 14:6)

There is only one living and true God. There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:2, 27; Matthew 28:19; I John 5:7)

We believe the Holy Bible to be the inspired Word of God. (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20, 21)

We believe Jesus Christ, conceived of the Virgin Mary, is the only begotten Son of the Father. Jesus was crucified, buried and rose from the dead. He ascended to heaven and is today at the right hand of the Father as the Intercessor. (Luke 1:26-33; Hebrews 7:25)

We believe we are justified (declared righteous under the blood of Jesus) when we repent of our sins and believe in Jesus Christ. (Acts 13:38, 39; Romans 5:1; I Corinthians 6:11; Mark 1:5)

We believe in the Baptism of the Holy Spirit with speaking in other tongues, as the Spirit gives the utterance, to be the initial evidence of this experience. We believe in the operation of the nine Gifts of the Spirit and encourage our people to live so that these gifts may be manifest in their lives. (Acts 2:4; Acts 10:44-46; Acts 19:6; I Corinthians 12:4-11)

We believe in the freedom of worship with every form of expression being done in decency and in order, not drawing attention to oneself. We define order in our services as following the anointing of the Holy Spirit through the pastoral leadership on the stage. (1 Corinthians 14:33, 40)

We believe in water baptism by immersion in water in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost. (Matthew 3:11; Matthew 28:18-19; John 14:6)

We believe in divine healing for the body. However, we encourage and do not condemn medical science. (Acts 3:2-12; Acts 5:15, 16; James 5:14-15)

We believe every blessing we receive from God comes through the merits of The Atonement (Jesus' complete sacrifice for us on Calvary). (Romans 5:11; James 1:16, 17)

We believe in the Second Coming of our Lord, Jesus Christ. (Acts 1:10, 11; I Thessalonians 4:13-18; Revelation 1:7)

We believe those who die outside of Christ will be punished in an eternal Hell, but those who die "in Him" shall share in His glory in Heaven forever. (Daniel 12:2; Matthew 25:46; John 5:29; Jude 1:7)

We believe in the sacredness of marriage between one man and one woman and family commitment. We promote strong family values. (Ephesians 5:31-33; Ephesians 6:1-4; Hebrews 13:4; Matthew 19:5; Leviticus 18:22; Genesis 2:24)

Chapter 34

God's Promotions Follow Obedience

God's Promotion Follows Obedience

Are you a leader? Do you oversee others? Are you following good role models or bad role models? Are you accountable for others? Do you know what God says about His leaders needing to live a pure lifestyle before Him – and others?

Seventeen years ago I gave the Lord a purity commitment not to drink, smoke, have sex outside of holy matrimony and not to make jokes about unholy living. Many times I am shunned because people don't like my teachings.

I was tested by God before He asked me to use the title of apostle. After God asked me to start using the title of apostle, He said to me "It is okay for you to make mistakes." There are areas that I have made mistakes, like accidentally sending an email to someone who it was not intended for, but the foundation that God has put inside of me by reading His Holy Bible has guided me to the true will of God for my life.

"Do not associate" were the words that came to me about 18 years ago when I was associating myself with a woman who called herself a Christian but she was living in the lifestyle of the bar and the dancing scene. The Holy Spirit ministered those words to me and then confirmed to me that it was God speaking to me by a minister at a Bible study within the next couple of weeks. The minister at the Bible study said to everyone "If God ever tells you not to associate with someone – don't associate with them" and I immediately stopped associating myself with that woman.

The pastor who told me this was in a lot of pain after a divorce and he was considering suicide. God also told him "If you commit suicide you will go to hell" and he had no idea of the impact of his true teachings for me and for others. His obedience and not committing suicide brings God glory and much fruit, at least in my life it does.

If you are in God's perfect will and you are a leader of people the best advice that I can give you, and to some this is an Ezekiel 33 warning - especially if you promote or encourage others to drink alcohol including

wine – is to abstain from evil or the appearances of evil (1 Thessalonians 5:22).

If you are an overseer of God's people your actions are not pleasing to the Lord if you are in sexual sin, drinking alcohol, doing drugs, or smoking cigarettes. If you are encouraging others to do the same then you should stop encouraging them to follow you or stop promoting that lifestyle is Christ-like and step down from a leadership position.

If you are a seer like I am then God may have revealed to you when someone was in sexual sin. He often shows me vivid dreams or visions of when someone is in sin. Sometimes it is to show me what He wants me to teach or bring correction to but many people shun me instead of changing their ways and they act like I have no kingdom authority to bring correction.

Leaders are held to a higher level of accountability and if you cause someone to stumble you will be held accountable. If I did not give this warning, and other private warnings, I would be held accountable to God too (Ezekiel 33).

If you want to lead God's people then you should know what God says about His leaders. God gives us examples of good kings and bad kings in His Word – The Holy Bible. He gives us many other examples of how to live holy lifestyles and to abstain from sinful lifestyles. A good leader will research the scriptures for themselves and believe that God has placed apostles in the land as part of His government, which is a higher level of authority than a sinful worldly government.

It grieves me to see worship leaders in God's sanctuary partaking in sinful lifestyles which includes drinking wine and promoting it.

I know two male leaders that God has told if they go back to doing the things in the world that He would let the devil take them. THAT is serious!

If your pastors are not teaching abstinence from these sins – they should be. If your leaders are not honoring God's ways, don't follow or

do the things that they do to promote it. God's promotion follows obedience.

Chapter 35

Trust & Kingdom Success

Can God trust you? Many times I see people wanting material things as a sign of success without actually earning their way to reaching the goal. God tests us with money and He tests our character.

Are you ready for success? Have you proven to God that you have the strength to carry all that He has for you? Are you testing God with your tithe? Are you showing yourself approved to God? Are you spending time with God? Are you spending your time wisely? Do you read the Holy Bible? Would you give someone money who you don't trust? Should God trust you with other people's money, how about with success?

God is omnipotent and can see all things. Sometimes people forget that God is watching and they go after material things instead of waiting for holier options. Not only is God watching but other people are watching.

Do you compromise the integrity of God's holiness by your actions to gain finances or material things, how about to fit in with others? God takes care of those who build His kingdom and not their own kingdoms.

Winning souls is a true measure of kingdom success. Don't worry about what man thinks. Do what is right in God's sight. Don't forget to always be good to people even if they have shunned you.

If you have been knocked down or derailed by circumstances outside of your control, persevere and God will restore you as you let your light shine.

True kingdom success needs to be focused on winning souls for the Lord no matter what type of employment you are in. You may be the only person that can reach someone in your sphere of influence.

Have you given God the credit and thanks for the blessings that you have now? Can you look back and see how God has blessed you in your life? How do you give God glory for what He has done in your life? Do you live in His ways of holiness or are you being a bad example to others by doing things which are not honorable?

As Christians mature they may have the favor of God and the favor of man. Can God trust you? Do other people trust you?

But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts. For neither at any time did we use flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak for covetousness—God is witness. Nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others, when we might have made demands as apostles of Christ (1 Thessalonians 2:4-6).

Chapter 36

Accountability

They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead (1 Peter 4:5).

Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful (1 Corinthians 4:1).

For a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money (Titus 1:7).

Read Luke 16:

He also said to His disciples: "There was a certain rich man who had a steward, and an accusation was brought to him that this man was wasting his goods. So he called him and said to him, 'What is this I hear about you? Give an account of your stewardship, for you can no longer be steward.'

"Then the steward said within himself, 'What shall I do? For my master is taking the stewardship away from me. I cannot dig; I am ashamed to beg. I have resolved what to do, that when I am put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses.'

"So he called every one of his master's debtors to him, and said to the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' And he said, 'A hundred

measures of oil.’ So he said to him, ‘Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.’ Then he said to another, ‘And how much do you owe?’ So he said, ‘A hundred measures[b] of wheat.’ And he said to him, ‘Take your bill, and write eighty.’ So the master commended the unjust steward because he had dealt shrewdly. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in their generation than the sons of light.

“And I say to you, make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home. He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? And if you have not been faithful in what is another man’s, who will give you what is your own?”

“No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.”

Be a good steward. Be accountable to others. Judge yourself and know those who labor among you (1 Thessalonians 5:12).
