

VALERIJA KUNDRAT

1911 - 1994

Valerija Kundrat, 83 of Sand Point passed away Tuesday, Jan. 11 at home, at home from exposure after she collapsed while shoveling snow.

She was born Jan. 6, 1911 in Celskiai, Lithuania, daughter of the late Alexander and Rosalija (Balseryte) Kurmauskas.

Mrs. Kundrat moved to the United States in 1951. She married Constantine Kundrat on Dec. 1, 1951. He preceded her in death on Sept. 27, 1971.

She was employed at the Childrens' Aid Society in Detroit for 22 years, retiring in 1973. She moved to Sand Point in 1976.

She was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church and the Women's Society in Caseville, Abelininkai (a Lithuanian society), the Lithuanian Women's Society of Detroit and the Caseville Retirement Club.

Surviving are one son, John of Egin, IL and two grandchildren.

Funeral services were conducted on Friday, Jan. 14 at St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville. The Rev. Dennis Kucharczyk, pastor and the Rev. Michael Kundrat, retired priest, officiated. A second service was held Saturday, Jan. 15 at the Church of Divine Providence in Southfield. Burial was in Holy Sepulcher Cemetery, Southfield.
