Old Business:

 - Don Kent said he would drive to Grissom AFB, Indiana and check on the progress of Huey 369. The chapter's interest remains with helping the local Huey Project. However, the Huey 369 project remains under consideration.
- **Reunion T-shirts:** Dale House will look into the status of the can-celed Colorado reunion T-shirts that were ordered.

New Business:
