



"FAILING TO PLAN IS PLANNING TO FAIL"

Doctor with terminal cancer kills paediatrician in hostage siege a childrens clinic

A doctor with terminal cancer killed a female paediatrician and then himself after taking hostages at a children's clinic in Austin, Texas.

Dr Bharat Narumanchi held hostages in a five-hour siege before killing Dr Katherine Lindley Dodson.

Narumanchi had applied for a volunteer position at the clinic a week ago and was declined.

He later came back carrying a pistol, a shotgun and two duffel bags.

Police spokesman Jeff Greenwalt said Narumanchi had recently been given "weeks to live" after a cancer diagnosis.

He said: "The case as far as who did this is closed. We know who did it. And we know that there's no longer a threat to the public. But we really, really want to answer the question of why."

Dr Lindley Dodson, 43, was beloved by patients and their families.

Karen Vladeck, whose two children were among her patients, told the Austin American-Statesman: "You saw her at your worst when your kid was sick, and she just always had a smile on her face.

"She made you feel like you were the only parent there, even though there was a line of kids waiting."

During the siege a SWAT team used a megaphone to communicate with the armed doctor.

A hostage negotiator shouted: "Your life is

very important to me. And I know life is very important to you.

"You don't deserve to go through this. For all you have done for others. That is why I want to help you work through this. You have saved a lot of lives." Police first sent in a robot and then of-

ficers went into the medical office where they found two bodies.

They did not comment on how the two doctors died.

A police spokesman said: "The SWAT situation has ended. Two subjects have been located and were pronounced deceased." Yahoo News Nick Allen







Sir Syed Ahmed Khan: A Visionary and Reformist of His Time

October 2020 was the one-hundredth anniversary of Aligarh Muslim University India, the first educational institution that offered science in India. It was among the first to introduce science in an institution of higher learning in the Muslim world after a hibernation of 500 years.

Sir Syed Ahmed was a great Muslim scholar, a great visionary, statesman, educator, and a Muslim reformer of the 19th century. He revived the teaching of Science to Aligarh Muslims after five centuries of neglect.

Muslims were at the forefront of science, technology, and innovation from the 7th till the 15th century. Due to the dominant Asharite ideology, the Muslim countries abandoned the teaching of science and philosophy. As a result, they lost their lead globally. It was more comfortable for the western world to colonize the entire Muslim world (including the great Safavid, Ottoman, and Mughal empires) during18th and 19th century.

Sir Syed was born when the British were colonizing India and Mughals were not able to defend themselves. He was one of the great thinkers, surrounded by Maulvis (Theologians) and poets among the Indian Muslims, who recognized that the severe underlying factor for the defeat and humiliation of the first war of Indian independence was lack of progress in science and technology. While Europeans were making technological advances, with leaps and bounds from the 16th century onwards, Muslims were going downhill by abandoning sciences in the Muslim universities.


Sir Syed recognized Muslims' pathetic conditions and felt deeply pained to see the educational backwardness dominating the masses. He made a mission of his life to bring Muslims out of Jahalia(ignorance) with very little support but loads of opposition. He foresaw that modern education was the only tool to uplift educationally backward masses' condition to compete and have dignity and respect.

Sir Syed Ahmad Khan was born in Delhi to a middle class, pious family on 17 October, 1817. His initial education was focused on learning Arabic, Persian, and Islamic studies. Later on, he studied the English language. In 1938 he was employed by East India Company, and after a few years of service, he served as Judge. During the 1857 revolt against the British, he witnessed British atrocities in which several of his fam-

ily members died. He wrote a book about his experiences highlighting the causes for a humiliating defeat in colonialists' hands. His book was translated into English and sent to the British Parliament and Queen Victoria members, and the East India Company got expelled from India

Soon after the 1857 Indian Revolt, he set up schools and convinced people to send their children for modern education. It was met with significant criticism owing to the educational backwardness of even great Muslim leaders of the time, as only a few realized the significance of his message.



He went to England (1869-70) and visited Oxford and Cambridge universities to study the British educational system. He observed that British people participated in the hard work of industrial development of their country, which was lacking in the Indian community. On his return, he set up a committee for establishing teaching institutions and started an influential journal, Tahdhib al-Akhlaq "Social Reform," for the "uplift and reform the Muslim." A Muslim school emerged at Aligarh in May 1875, and after his retirement in 1876, Syed devoted himself to enlarging it into a college. He also organized a "Scientific Society" at Aligarh, where he entrusted scholars with translating the great scientific works from English to Urdu and Hindi to make them understandable to the masses.

Sir Syed Ahmad Khan founded Mohammaden Anglo-Oriental College (MAO College), which became the Aligarh Muslim University on 14 September 1920. His motto was "a true Muslim is one who must have the Holy Quran in one hand and the book of science in the other." His supreme interest was the intellectual development of the people through modern education.

He wrote several volumes of a modernist commentary on the holy Quran, several books on Islam, and hundreds of articles to motivate Muslims to get modern education. He argued that understanding the Quran rested on a deep appreciation of reason and natural law and therefore did not preclude Muslim involvement in scientific methodology. He explained that "Religion is the word of God and our surroundings are the work of God. An explanation of the existence of the work of God is Science.

Hence, no contradiction possible between Science and Religion as the word of God cannot be in opposition to the work of God."



Syed Ahmad considered

Madrasa Education better than what the British schools offered in terms of Islamic Education, but it is unlikely to lead Muslims into a new future. He emphasized Western Education's importance and persuaded his coreligionists to abandon their conventional approach of supporting indigenous institutions and adopting new knowledge in these institutions. His supreme interest was the intellectual development of the people through modern education.

He based his education philosophy on science, theology, and morality as an integrated education system. He introduced rationalism in theology and initiated modernist reforms in India's Muslim society when Muslim morale was down and prevented it from decline and cultural decay. He faced severe criticism from religious orthodoxy when learning the English language was considered sinful. His advocacy of Western Education of Science and English caused apprehensions and doubts in people's minds. Many Muslims were perplexed due to clergy that believed that modern education was incompatible with and against the religion. It was of no surprise as science as a subject in any university of the Muslim world since the 15th century. Orthodox Muslims opposed him for his progressive, liberal and secular views and labeled him a Kafir. Deobandi clerics opposed his proposal, saying that they cannot associate an institution with Shia students on the campus. Several Muslim scholars had signed fatwas accusing Sir Syed of disbelief and apostasy. One cleric went all the way to Makkah and secured a fatwa calling for Sir Syed's beheading if he persisted with his plans to establish the college.

In his famous speech at the foundation of MAO College, he said: "Oh my dear children, you had reached a particular stage, and remember one thing that when I undertook the task, there was criticism all-around against me, and abuses upon me. Life had become so difficult for me that I aged before my age. I lost my hair, my eyesight, but not my vision. My vision never dimmed, my determination never failed, I built this institution for you, and I am sure you will carry the light of this institution far and wide; darkness will disappear from all around". It summarizes his lifetime struggle to build Aligarh University, a fine institution of higher education in India.

If Sir Syed were alive today, he would continue to experience pain because his community remains in the same state as it once was in his time. Due to science's introduction in the educational system, the universities produce Muslim doctors, engineers, and IT professionals. Un-

fortunately, none of the universities are producing scientists. Education among Muslims remains the same or slid down to a lower status in some indices. 40% to 50% in urban and 60% to 70% of Muslims remain illiterate in rural areas. A significant Muslim population still prefer sending their children to indigenous institutions like Madrasas where they are not getting any education in science. The belief that religious sciences and worldly sciences are separate and mutually opposed is still prevalent. Students in both the categories, those in modern educational institutions and those in Madrasas, are not getting a proper understanding of Islam, as explained by Sir Syed, which is a complete way of life and commands everyone to excel in Islamic and worldly knowledge.

Today we can see the Aligarh Muslim University graduates in every field of activity in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, the Middle East, Europe, and the United States. Although Aligahr alumni celebrate its founder, Sir Syed, worldwide, I have never heard a talk about his mission of promoting science education. Sir Syed spent all his life improving Muslim Ummah's status by raising educational standards and bringing them out of shackles of western power and other oppressors. Unfortunately, Muslims are not making enough progress in realizing his dreams. To reiterate, Sir Syed emphasized:

"Acquisition of knowledge of science and technology is the only solution for the problems of Muslims; otherwise, Muslims will remain humiliated and rejected."

"Ijtihad (innovation, re-interpretation with the changing times) is needed to overcome taqlid (following old values) and to develop new ideas..."

He pointed out not to show what Islam preaches, instead "show your behavior as the follower of true Islam representing the character, education, knowledge, tolerance and piety, and selfless service to humanity."

"Education alone in the present context can empower Muslims and noth-

ing else. Muslims can create a modern Islamic society only by promoting modern Education like Sciences, medical Education, engineering, teaching, management, etc. God has given the eyes to see and the mind to analyze. We must see what is happening around us and use our intellect to conclude. It is what Allah wants us to do. In short, we must develop a scientific temper among the people as the holy Quran says in different verses".

Dr. Allama Iqbal says about Sir Syed:

"The real greatness of the man (Sir Syed) consists in the fact that he was the first Indian Muslim who felt the need of a fresh orientation of Islam and worked for it." This great visionary and reformer, Sir Syed Ahmed Khan, will always remain alive in our memory, inspiring the right Islamic thinking to make progress in this world and regain the intellectual leadership that was part of Muslim heritage."

Dallas County is currently scheduling appointments for individuals who are 65 or older with an underlying high-risk health condition.

How to register for a vaccination?

COVID-19 Vaccine is still in very limited supply and is still being prioritized to Phase 1A Healthcare Workers. However, limited supplies of vaccine may be available for persons who meet the Phase 1B criteria (Persons 65 and older, or persons 16+ with underlying medical conditions). DCHHS is collecting names of persons to register for the vaccine, as vaccine becomes available. To register for the vaccine, you need to be in Phase 1A or 1B at this time. Again, those groups include doctors, nurses, first responders, as well as individuals 65 and older and 18 or older with an underlying medical condition. Dallas County is distributing the Moderna vaccine at this time, which is only available to individuals 18 and older.

Each entity that is distributing the vaccine may approach this process differently, so if you plan to receive your immunization from a hospital, pharmacy or doctor, it will be a different registration process.

On the joyous occasion of India's 72nd Republic Day on Tuesday, I would like to extend my warm greetings and felicitations to all Indian nationals, persons of Indian origin, and friends of India in Saudi Arabia.

Republic Day reminds us of the values enshrined in our constitution, which came into effect on Jan. 26, 1950 and declared India a sovereign, socialist, secular and democratic republic. India is one of the oldest civilizations in the world and has always absorbed and amalgamated new ideas, customs, and traditions. In the process it has diversified and enriched its own culture. As a result, India has emerged as a modern, forward-looking country that boasts an inclusive and plural society, providing equal opportunities for all its citizens. As the world becomes more globalized and interconnected, India stands out as a country with a global outlook because of its belief in transparency, openness, and market principles, and its eagerness to share its knowledge and resources with the rest of the world.

India has been at the forefront of the new economic resurgence in Asia: Its economy has grown at an average annual rate of around 7 percent over the last decade. The year 2020 was undoubtedly a difficult one for the global economy owing to the impact of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. That resulted in a "technical recession" in India and the contraction of the country's economy by about 7.7 percent during 2020-21.

Fortunately, India's economy is now headed for recovery based on a revival in the demand for consumer goods, high manufacturing activity, and a major economic stimulus package of \$266 billion. The package was extended by the government in key growth-focused projects in addition to implementing bold economic reforms. The rollout earlier this month of the biggest COVID-19 vaccination campaign in the world has also sent comforting signals to global investors. Despite the pandemic, the total foreign direct investment inflows into India were a record \$50 billion, including inflows worth over \$20 billion in capital markets. India was one of the two emerging markets to see positive inflows despite the pandemic. India is moving on a path toward reclaiming its title as the world's fastest-growing major economy. The London-based data and analytics firm GlobalData has projected a GDP growth rate of 9.7 percent during 2021. Other business entities have forecast a GDP growth rate as high as 12 percent for India despite the World Bank conservatively projecting India's GDP growth at 5.4 percent in 2021. ARAB NEWS

Byron Sigcho (25th) to bring permanent testing sites to communities that need them the most. Fauci feared Americans may 'start doing dangerous and foolish things' after Trump suggested 'injecting' bleach

Dr Anthony Fauci, director of the National Institute for Allergy and Infectious Disease, was in a state of shock when he first heard former President Donald Trump's comments about disinfectant working as a potential remedy to Covid-19.

"I just said, 'Oh my goodness gracious," he recalled in a CNN interview about that day in April, when Mr Trump suggested bleach could act as a therapeutic to the novel virus from behind the White House podium.

"I could just see what's going to happen," Dr Fauci added. "You're going to have people who hear that from the president and they're going to start doing dangerous and foolish things."

The nation's leading epidemiologist has been back in the headlines following President Joe Biden's inauguration, acknowledging in multiple interviews how he was "blocked" from speaking with certain outlets like MSNBC's The Rachel Maddow Show by the previous administration.

He has since spoken out about what it was like serving on Mr Trump's coronavirus response task force at the White House, where he said the former president was receiving both "good information and bad information" about the ongoing crisis. By the end of his administration, the former president had largely removed scientists and leading infectious disease experts from his inner circle, instead focusing on counsel from his ex-chief strategist Steve Bannon, and Mike Lindell, CEO of MyPillow — yet Dr Fauci remained in his post until Mr Biden was sworn in last week.

"Unfortunately, the concept of anecdotal as opposed to science-driven information seemed to prevail," Dr Fauci told CNN about the previous administration, adding: "I took no great pleasure out of contradicting the President, but I had to get out just to maintain my own integrity, but also to stand up for science that the data did not show what they were claiming."

Mr Trump was speaking about potential

coronavirus treatments as the outbreak swept across the country last year when he told reporters: "Then I see the disinfectant, where it knocks it out in one minute."

He then looked over at his

team — Dr Fauci was not present at the time — and posed the following question: "Is there a way we can do something like that by injection inside, or almost a cleaning?"

"Because you see it gets in the lungs and it does a tremendous number on the lungs," he continued, "so it'd be interesting to check that."

State and local health officials came out swiftly after the former president spoke last year at the White House press conference, warning against injecting or otherwise consuming disinfectants like bleach. Even leading disinfectant companies like Lysol and Clorox released urgent warnings



to customers against using their products as potential therapeutics for the novel virus.

Some officials said their states received hundreds of calls from residents with inquiries about whether disinfectants worked when ingested in the body to prevent Covid-19, as CNN noted, including Maryland's Republican Governor Larry Hogan.

Donald Harris, Kamala Harris's Dad, Is a Renowned Stanford Professor

Kamala Harris has spoken openly and frequently about her heritage. Being the daughter of two immigrants has affected her perspective of the world, her personal life (including her oft-mispronounced name, which means "lotus" in Sanskrit), and her stance on many issues. An important piece of her backstory is Kamala's father, Donald Harris, a former economics professor at Stanford and an immigrant from Jamaica, who has...thoughts about some things Kamala has said. He lives close to Kamala, and recent reports claim they're on "good terms," but she's made comments that suggest that she was closer to her late mother. It sounds like they have an important, but complicated relationship, so here's what we know about it.

Donald Harris was born in Jamaica. According to his Stanford bio, Donald is a naturalized U.S. citizen (which unfortunately sparked bogus, and racist, claims that Kamala isn't eligible to run for office). Donald attended the University of California Berkeley and worked at the University of Wisconsin (Madison) before coming to California. He's traveled extensively, and has spoken often about the economic situation in his home nation of Jamaica and how to improve the economy there and in other developing nations.

In fact, during his time at Stanford, he acted as economic consultant to the Jamaican government and advisor to various prime ministers there. Renee Anne Shirley, former advisor to the Jamaican prime minister, said, "In three years, he got tenure—think about it, a Black man—and then he left and went to go to Stanford? He is a big thing for us...He pushed the boundaries. He was way ahead of his time."

He was a prominent professor at Stanford. According to his bio, Donald joined the faculty at Stanford in 1972. His focus has been "exploring the analytical conception

of the process of capital accumulation and its implications for a theory of growth of the economy, with the aim of providing thereby an explanation of the intrinsic character of growth as a process of uneven development."

According to The Oprah Magazine, he taught undergraduate classes such as "Theory of Capitalist Development" and graduate students in a program named, "Alternative Approaches to Economic Analysis." He was deemed a "Marxist" scholar by The Stanford Daily, indicating that "there was some opposition to granting him tenure because he was 'too charismatic, a pied piper leading students astray from neo-Classical economics." Nevertheless, he was the first Black person to receive tenure in Stanford's economics department, and people who knew him say they can see his tenacity and spirited argumentation in his daughter's political debates. He also was apparently a strong mentor to students and knew quite a bit about Howard University, which Kamala

He's now been retired since 1998, and holds the title of emeritus professor. He now works on "developing public policies to promote economic growth and advance social equity."

He was divorced from Kamala's mother. Kamala's mother, Shyamala Gopalan, passed away in 2009 of colon cancer. She and Donald separated when Kamala was five and divorced when she was seven. Donald immigrated to the U.S. to go to school at Berkeley and met Gopalan there.

The pair crossed paths when Gopalan met Donald at one of his off-campus meetings in 1962 that discussed the parallels between Jamaica and the U.S. After the meeting was over, Gopalan was interested in his ideas. She went up to him to intro-

duce herself. He recalled her to The New York Times, "a standout in appearance relative to everybody else in the group of both men and women."

Despite growing up on opposites sides of the world, the ideas Donald presented intrigued Gopalan. "This was all very interesting to me, and, I daresay, a bit charming," he recalled in the interview. "At a subsequent meeting, we talked


again, and at the one after that. The rest is now history." They were married in 1963.

Funny enough, Gopalan didn't plan on staying past her college years. "I came to study at UC Berkeley," she said to SF Weekly. "I never came to stay. It's the old story: I fell in love with a guy, we got married, pretty soon kids came." Kamala was born in 1964, and her sister came two years later.

According to Harris' autobiography, The Truths We Hold, their marriage and decision to stay in the U.S. "were the ultimate acts of self-determination and love." Her first exposure to protests and demonstrations was apparently a "stroller's-eye view."

In a 2018 essay written by Donald, he discussed the divorce, saying it "came to an abrupt halt in 1972" after losing a "hard-fought custody battle in the family court of Oakland, California." He explained that despite the divorce, his love for his family never faltered. "Nevertheless, I persisted, never giving up on my love for my children or reneging on my responsibilities as their father."

In The Truths We Hold, Harris spoke about her parents' relationship, writing,



"had they been a little older, a little more emotionally mature, maybe the marriage could have survived. But they were so young. My father was my mother's first boyfriend." The friction in the family was a source of worry for her, including when she invited both parents to her high school graduation, "even though I knew they wouldn't speak to each other."

Gopalan's brother told The New York Times: "She was quite unhappy about the separation but she had already got used to that and she didn't want to talk to Don after that. When you love somebody, then love turns into very hard bitterness, you don't even want to talk to them."

Initially, the family lived in California; Kamala talked about being bussed to school in California in the first Democratic debate. According to the San Francisco Chronicle, she was "part of the second class to integrate Berkeley's classrooms when she began school in 1969." The project achieved national recognition for its efficacy at the time. Kamala moved away at 12 years old when her mother got a research job in Canada. Yahoo life

Biden plans to replace the US government's fleet of 650,000 vehicles with electric models in a shift to clean energy

President Joe Biden said Monday he plans to replace the "enormous fleet" of government vehicles with electric models.

The switch will help create one million new autoworker jobs in the US, he said.

Biden said he'll change the rules that currently allow vehicles to be considered American-made even if they have parts made in other countries.

President Joe Biden said his new administration will replace the US government's fleet of around 650,000 vehicles with electric models in a bid to shift to clean energy.

Whilst signing a new "Buy American" executive order, Biden said: "The federal

government also owns an enormous fleet of vehicles, which we're going to replace with clean electric vehicles made right here in America made by American workers."

It's unclear when the electric vehicles will rollout and which models they will be. Reuters reported it could cost \$20 billion or more to fully replace the fleet. The White House didn't immediately respond to Insider's request for comment. Biden, 78, said the fleet replacement will help create one million new jobs in the American auto industry.

"This will be the largest mobilization of public investment and procurement, infrastructure and R&D, since World War II," office on January 20.
The 46th President of the US criticized the current rules that allow vehicles to be considered American-made when bought by the US government even if they carry components which come from other countries.

The current standards require at least half a vehicle's parts to be US-made to be considered American, according to Biden.

"We're going to change that as well. The executive action I'm signing today will not only require the companies make more of their components in America, but that the

On 5th July 2020, Ikonkar Manmohan Singh Sandhu, a young 23 year old boy, died from an opioid overdose in Michigan just months before he was to be married. He is by no means an isolated case in the Indian American community.

A small group of doctors are sounding the alarm on the nation's opioid crisis. Dr. Arun Gupta is one of those who is urging health authorities to wake up to this catastrophe, which is ripping through communities with scant regard for race, gender, educational level or financial standing.

To be fair, before COVID-19 ravaged the country, the growing opioid addiction was giving the nation's health officials sleepless nights. The pandemic put this issue on the back burner and while more Americans are dying from the virus, it can be just as deadly if left unchecked.

Opioid overdoses have killed more than 70,000 young people annually between the ages of

18-54 for the past five years. In 2011, the CDC reported that overdose deaths superseded auto accident deaths for the first time in 32 states This is now virtually true for all 50 states. The organization also reported that more than 700,000 young Americans have died between 1999- 2017 from poly drug overdose. That number is expected to be as high as one million by the end of 2020. The report further states that, "preventable disease & retroactive analysis show that most of these deaths were unintentional." Isolation, stress and the depression, that came in the wake of the pandemic is shooting cases through the roof. "Parents are burying their children and children are burying their parents," says Dr. Gupta.

Dr. Gupta is quick to rid you of the rosy view that Indo American families have been unaffected by this affliction. It is a growing trend in the community, he says, largely due to parents' unrealistic expectations for their children or the ABCD generation that faces conflicting cultures. What worsens it, is that many are either in denial or wary of seeking professional help for fear of being stigmatized or shunned. These are lives that could have easily been saved, he laments, much like the case of a distant relative who died because the family hesitated to reach out for help or were unaware of the problem.

A physician for 34 years, of which 14 are as a doctor of addiction management, Dr. Gupta has seen enough to be worried. He has been charting the surge in cases throughout the nation for the past decade and is seeing it played out at his doorstep - the rural region of Monroe, Michigan where he runs his private practice.

For 11 years, Dr Gupta was the local prison doctor where he saw the interplay of drugs and death up close and the ineffectiveness of the administration's efforts to curb it. This pushed him to change tracks from being a general physician to addiction management. Rural communities, he observes, are more prone to opioid addiction than urban areas where the population is better educated and have higher paying jobs. The problem is compounded when there is family instability, lack of education, poverty, physical, mental and sexual abuse in childhood, mental illness or addiction both in the family and the

So why are addictive opioids prescribed in the first place and how do they hook us? About 25 years ago, pharma company Purdue, manufacturers of the painkiller Oxycodone, pushed the government to sanction prescribing painkillers for non-cancer related pain. The American Pain Society also classified pain as the fifth vital sign after blood pressure, pulse, temperature, and weight. Statistically, 40% of the country's population is in chronic pain and many require pain medication to carry out their daily activities or even go in to work.

Addiction starts innocuously enough with a prescription for a painkiller to treat postsurgery or chronic pain as in instances of back pain. Consuming these painkillers diminishes the pain but also brings on a euphoric feeling as it raises dopamine - the brain's pleasure hormone. Celebrities like Michael Jackson were known to use them before a performance, a term referred to as, "spotlight euphoria." Additionally, it changes the perception of reality for those dealing with psychological issues such as an inferiority complex or anxiety, these people now start "liking themselves and feeling good." This altered reality quickly spirals into an emotional and social need followed by dependence and cravings for the painkiller.

The signs of addiction are evident in drastic mood changes, lethargy or impaired decision-making, among others. Discontinuing the painkillers could lead to a host of withdrawal symptoms such as chills, tremors, body aches, bone pain, vomiting, diarrhea or irregular respiration. However, Dr. Gupta clarifies that not everyone gets addicted to painkillers and the risk of addiction is only about 10%.

Soon, Oxycodone grew so popular that it began to have, "street value." When prescriptions ran out, users turned to the streets where it could be obtained illegally. Hustlers began faking health issues to procure and sell these painkillers giving rise to the term "pill-mill." The cost of one milligram of Oxycontin is one dollar so someone using 1000mg was spending \$1000 a day. While insurance took care of legitimate prescriptions, those who were addicted were shelling out their own money. This, of course, was done in connivance with "some doctors who played the game." Dr. Gupta estimates that about 1000 doctors have been apprehended so far for violating this practice and have "tarnished the image of doctors."

There is an obvious connection between mental disorders and addictive disorders and its consequences can sometimes be

life threatening. Doctors, however, are required by law to treat pain with painkillers even if there is a sense/awareness that this medication could become addictive to the patient. On the other hand, if doctors practice caution in prescribing pain medication, they risk a bad review on their practice, something every doctor understandably wants to avoid.

In 1999, the Center for Disease Control went on record for the first time and shared its report of 4000 young Americans who died from drugs. The government scrutinized the problem and rolled out the Drug Ad-

diction Treatment Act of 2000. For the first time, this law allowed practicing doctors to learn and treat addiction with an FDA approved drug. The law also stipulated that any practicing doctor could complete an addiction program and receive a X DEA license which would allow them to treat 30 patients per month for a year. If the doctor's records are found in order, they could treat 100 patients per month. Past President Barack Obama signed a law that would allow some doctors with specific credentials to treat 275 patients a month. This number was controlled to prevent its misuse but sometimes the best-intentioned laws have unintended consequences.

This one did. Only 4300 doctors in the US can treat 275 patients a month and Dr. Gupta is one of them. It's a drop in the ocean for the estimated 20-40 million people who need help overcoming their addiction. There are more than 100,000 healthcare providers in the country that include doctors, nurses and physician assistants who have the necessary X- DEA credentials to treat opioid use disorders. But less than 20,000 are actively involved in dealing with the growing opioid epidemic in the country. This lack of access to a healthcare provider aggravates the problem leading to more deaths than recoveries. Meanwhile, the pandemic has not made things easier. There is excessive stress and limited counselling due to the shutdowns and prescriptions cannot be given on the phone without the necessary drug testing. This explains the rise in overdose deaths and addiction cases in the past nine months.

Apart from flawed policy, the American Society of Addiction states that every doctor who graduates from medical school is required to study addiction management. There are 179 medical schools and approximately 9000 residency programs in the country and not one of them teaches this course. Moreover, addiction management is not considered on par with other areas of medical specialization and neither do insurance companies view addiction



like other chronic diseases such as blood pressure or diabetes.

In 2002, a drug Buprenorphine was approved for addiction treatment and ten years later another drug Zubsolv made it to treatment plans. These drugs block the opioid receptors in the brain and reduce a person's craving for the painkiller. Another ingredient in the drug, naloxone, reverses the effects of opioids. Together, they prevent withdrawal symptoms and deter the abuser from snorting or injecting it. Dr. Gupta pairs medication with counselling, and non-addictive medication in cases of insomnia or anxiety. Recovery takes anywhere from six weeks to six months depending on the severity of the addiction, but the struggle to remain clean continues for the rest of their lives.

With death rates from opioid misuse surging, more than 500 laws were enacted in the last 10 years against doctors, pill mills and pharmaceutical companies to curb the problem but this has only exacerbated the issue. Addicts are now forced to go to the streets instead of visiting a doctor for treatment. Dr. Gupta notes that national autopsy results over the last 5 years consistently show that fentanyl, heroin and cocaine are the first three drugs in more than 55% of the people with drug overdose deaths as opposed to prescription medica-

Over the past few years, Dr. Gupta has presented more than 150 talks to schools, doctors, healthcare systems and social organizations like Rotary clubs and the Kiwanis Club to highlight the gravity of the problem and his message that addiction can be cured. He is talking to elected officials to leverage their influence and galvanize the government to rethink the limit of patients and allow greater access to people who want to overcome their addiction.

Addiction, he warns, has become synonymous with a death sentence in this country.

As Trump Seeks to Remain a Political Force, **New Targets Emerge**

Former President Donald Trump, determined to remain a force in GOP politics, is gaining new opportunities with a crucial Senate seat unexpectedly coming open in Ohio, an ally announcing for governor of Arkansas, and rising pressure on Republicans in Congress who did not stand with him during this month's impeachment

The surprise announcement on Monday by Sen. Rob Portman of Ohio that he would not seek a third term sparked a political land rush, with top strategists in the state receiving a flood of phone calls from potential candidates testing their viability. One consultant said he had received calls from five would-be candidates by midday.

That opening, along with another statewide contest next year in which Gov. Mike DeWine is expected to face at least one Trump-aligned primary challenger, is likely to make Ohio a central battleground for control of the Republican Party, and an inviting one for Trump, who held on to Ohio in the election while losing three other northern battleground states. Portman's announcement came hours after Sarah Huckabee Sanders, Trump's former White House press secretary, began her campaign for Arkansas governor. The Republican primary there already includes the state's lieutenant governor and attorney general, but private polling indicates that Sanders is beginning well ahead, and Trump endorsed her candidacy on Monday night.

Trump has only been out of the presidential office five days and has little in the way of political infrastructure. He has told aides he would like to take a break for several months.

But the former president has remained the party's strongest fundraiser, with tens of millions in PAC money at his disposal, and he retains an enduring base of Republican support across the country. Perhaps most importantly, he harbors a deep-seated desire to punish those he believes have crossed him and reward those who remain loyal.

So far he has focused primarily on Georgia, where he believes the Republican governor and secretary of state betrayed him by certifying his loss there. Both are up for reelection in 2022. And he took something of a test run over the weekend by getting involved in the leadership fight in Arizona's Republican Party, after Kelli Ward, the firebrand chairwoman, asked for his help in gaining reelection, according to a person familiar with the discussions.

Already there is a movement at the state and local levels to challenge incumbent members of Congress seen as breaking with the former president, starting with the 10 Republicans who voted to impeach him earlier this month.

The overwhelming consensus among Ohio Republicans is that a Trump-aligned candidate would be best positioned to win a competitive Senate primary, and no potential candidate has a better claim to Trump's voters in the state than Rep. Jim Jordan, who was Trump's chief defender during his first impeachment trial and received the Presidential Medal of Freedom during the former president's final days in office. "Jim is well positioned if in fact he's ready to take that leap; I'm not sure there's anybody that would beat him," said Ken Blackwell, a former Ohio secretary of state and longtime Portman ally who last month served as an Electoral College voter for Trump. Referring to Trump's legion of supporters, Blackwell added: "In Ohio, it's going to be who has the track record to show that their agenda respects the newly realigned party base."

Trump is now ensconced at his Mar-a-Lago resort in Florida, where aides are building something that can serve as an office. He's been golfing several times, and was spotted by people at his club in Florida playing with the brother of former tennis star Anna Kournikova on Sunday.

His advisers have had discussions about whether to get him back on some form of social media platform, although they insist he does not need to be on Twitter or Facebook to raise money, and that his email solicitations continue to work well. On Monday he formally opened the Office of the Former President, to manage his "correspondence, public statements, appearances, and official activities."

As President Joe Biden's inauguration approached, Trump began telling some allies that he was considering forming a third party if Republicans moved to convict him in the Senate trial. But by Saturday, after his own advisers said it was a mistake, Trump started sending out word that he was moving on from his threat.

"He understands that the best thing for his movement and conservatism is to move forward together, that third parties will lead to dominance by Democrats," said Sen. Lindsey Graham, R-S.C., who is a close ally of Trump.

Advisers to the president say he has just over \$70 million in his PAC, Save America, with few restrictions on what he can do with it. For now, most of his staff is on a government payroll afforded to former presidents for a period of time after they leave office.

Officials are working to mend Trump's relationship with Rep. Kevin McCarthy, R-Calif., the House minority leader, whom Trump called a vulgarity for his House floor speech denouncing the former president's rally address before the riot at the Capitol on Jan. 6. A senior Republican said that aides to the two men were trying to arrange a meeting or a call in the coming days. And Trump's eldest son, Donald Trump Jr., spoke with McCarthy recently and the two are on good terms, a person briefed on the call said.

Trump would like to seek retribution against House members who voted against



him, and he's been particularly angry with Reps. Anthony Gonzalez of Ohio and Fred Upton of Michigan, advisers said. He will also at some point focus on the governor's race in Arizona, where Doug Ducey cannot seek reelection; Gov. Greg Abbott's reelection bid in Texas; and the Senate race in North Carolina, as places where he can show strength, the advisers said. (One adviser disputed that Trump would have an interest in the Texas race.)

In Ohio, Gonzalez faces a potential primary challenge from Christina Hagan, a former state legislator whom he defeated in a 2018 primary. Hagan lost in the general election last year to Rep. Tim Ryan, a Democrat, in a neighboring district. She said in an interview Monday that she will decide which, if any, race to enter in 2022 after Ohio redraws its congressional districts; the state is likely to lose one seat and Republicans control all levers of redistricting.

"A lot of people elected what they thought was conservative leadership and now are witnessing somebody cutting against their values," Hagan said, alluding to Gonzalez's vote to impeach.

Gonzalez's office did not respond to emails seeking comment.

Trump's deepest hostility is reserved for Gov. Brian Kemp of Georgia, advisers said, and they expect he will expend the most energy trying to damage Kemp's reelection bid. The governor's original sin was in choosing Kelly Loeffler over Trump's favored candidate, Doug Collins, to fill a vacant Senate seat in 2019, but it evolved into something more consuming as Trump repeated his debunked claims of widespread fraud in the state and held Kemp responsible for not doing enough to challenge the election results.

Collins, a hard-line Trump backer, hasn't decided whether to challenge Kemp or seek the Republican nomination against Sen. Raphael Warnock, the Democrat who defeated Loeffler in a special election and will face voters again in 2022, or if he will choose not to run for anything, a Collins aide said Monday.

Next on Trump's personal hit list is Rep. Liz Cheney, R-Wyo., people close to him said. Cheney was the only member of the House GOP leadership to vote to impeach. It's unclear whether Trump will target her seat, or simply her leadership post in the House, but advisers said they anticipate he will take opportunities to damage her.

Sarah Longwell, the executive director of the Republican Accountability Project, an anti-Trump group, said she and her colleagues plan to raise and spend \$50million to defend the 10 pro-impeachment House Republicans in primary contests and attack those who voted to object to the Electoral College results after the Jan. 6 riot at the Capitol. She said the group would aim to defeat Jordan in an Ohio Senate primary if he runs against an establishment-minded Republican. Jordan's spokesman did not respond to messages on Monday.

The 2022 map will be the first real test of Trump's durability in the party. While Sanders is running for governor in Arkansas, rumors that his daughter Ivanka would run for Senate in Florida are unlikely to develop further. And though his daughter-in-law, Lara Trump, was said to be considering a Senate run in North Carolina, people close to the family say it is less clear what she will do now that Donald Trump lost.

Trump's advisers are more focused on the looming impeachment trial. He is working closely with Graham, who has argued to his colleagues that Trump's Senate trial sets a bad precedent.

Graham helped him retain a South Carolina-based lawyer, Butch Bowers, who is also working to fill out a legal team with colleagues from the state, Graham and others said. Bowers is expected to work with a Trump adviser, Jason Miller, on some kind of response operation.

Unlike his first impeachment trial, when the Republican National Committee engaged in a constant defense of the president, including paying for his lawyers, this time it is expected to focus only on rapid response, including calling the Senate trial unconstitutional and a procedural overreach, two people familiar with the committee's plans said.

If you're juggling federal student loan debt along with other bills, you're about to get another pandemic-related break.

Those who lost a job during the pandemic and now need to decide whether to pay their student loan debt or buy groceries can hold off making federal student loan payments through Sept. 30.

The temporary pause for federal student loan payments had been set to end Jan. 31 for more than 42 million borrowers. The move means that the interest rate on many federal student loan payments stays set at 0% for another eight months. (But remember, millions of private student loan payments and some federal student loans weren't covered by this deal.)

Time to breathe and pay down other

"It really gives people options to get their financial life in order," said Kristen Holt, CEO of GreenPath Financial Wellness, a Michigan-based nonprofit that offers various services nationwide, including a debt management program and financial counseling on student loans.

Some families, Holt said, may be able to use this time to pay off high-rate credit card debt or other bills. Others, if able, might try to set aside extra cash to create or beef up an emergency fund.

Taking care of some other financial headaches, Holt said, will put many families on a better footing once payments on student loan bills must resume later this year.

Save better, spend better: We'll tell you how and send money tips, advice delivered right to your inbox. Sign up here "Right now," Holt said, "nothing is forgiven. They still owe the money."

The temporary financial break, which was first announced in March, was extended twice last year and then again, most recently at the request of President Joe Biden, who took executive action on the matter on his first day in office.

"Too many Americans are struggling to pay for basic necessities and to provide for their families," according to an alert from the U.S. Department of Education.

"They should not be forced to choose between paying their student loans and putting food on the table."

Time to review income-driven plans Holt told me in a phone interview that many borrowers should consider signing up for income-driven repayment plans even now while the pause is in place.

That's because the months when they're not required to make a payment will

count in their favor with some incomedriven plans that offer loan forgiveness at the end of a 20 year or 25 year period.

Mark Kantrowitz, a student loan expert, noted that the CARES Act, passed in March, specifically counts the payment pause and interest waiver as though the payments were made.

Kantrowitz said he generally advises borrowers to consider an income-driven repayment plan if their total student loan debt at graduation exceeds their annual income, especially if they want to pursue Public Service Loan Forgiveness.

The budget-friendly, income-driven plans offered on federal student loans can help you avoid defaulting if your income is low compared with your student debt burden. In general, monthly payments are calculated based on borrowers' incomes and family sizes and the plans may be more affordable than other

Typically, experts say, borrowers should opt for the repayment plan with the highest monthly payment that they can afford so that the interest doesn't keep building over the long run.

Will there be another pause in payments after September? The Biden administration has left open that possibility. But borrowers would be wise to take advantage of what they know is available right now.

What happens after the pause? Sarah Sattelmeyer, director of the Pew Charitable Trust's Student Borrower Success project, said financially strapped borrowers need to consider what happens when the payment pause ends.

The latest extension, she said, offers essential breathing room for borrowers during a time when many have lost jobs or seen their hours cut during the pandemic.

But many borrowers still may face difficulty even if the jobs picture improves, as some expect once more people receive a coronavirus vaccine.

"Even before the pandemic, a lot of families were struggling financially," Sattelmeyer said.

"Family financial security really drives borrowers' repayment behavior."

Policymakers should be using this time, she said, to put measures in place to help student loan borrowers smoothly transition back into making payments when that is required.

In addition, Kantrowitz notes that loan servicers will face challenges restarting repayment on all the borrowers all of a



sudden, too.

Americans seem anxious about an uncertain future, according to Pew research, with nearly a quarter who are not confident that their household will be financially secure in six months.

"In addition, 58% of borrowers reported that it would be difficult to resume student loan payments in the next month if they had to do so," according to a Pew survey released in October.

Sattelmeyer said those who are at the greatest financial risk will need more help once the payment pause ends.

In the future, some borrowers may need a grace period after the pause in payments ends that can help people who maybe miss their first couple payments right after the program ends. A safety net needs to be in place, she said.

What's often not understood, she said, is that not all student loans are covered by this pause in payments.

About 9 million borrowers — those with private student loans and those with most Perkins loans and Federal Family Education Loans that are not owned by the federal government — are not receiving automatic relief, according to the Student Borrower Protection Center, a nonprofit advocacy group.

With private student loans, borrowers must request relief and their options may be very limited. It all depends on what the lender might offer, if anything at all. Some short-term solutions offered earlier have even expired, according to the Student Borrower Protection Center.

"Borrowers with commercially-held FFEL Program and Perkins loans may be able to get assistance, but it is neither automatic nor as comprehensive as that provided to those with federally held loans," Pew's Sattelmeyer said.

Kantrowitz noted that borrowers with FFEL loans and Federal Perkins Loans

can make their loans eligible by consolidating them into a Federal Direct Consolidation Loan.

He noted that FFEL borrowers may be eligible for other types of financial relief, such as economic hardship deferments, unemployment deferments, forbearances and income-driven repayment. The monthly payment under an incomedriven repayment plan is zero if the borrower's income is less than 150% of the poverty line.

Pew Charitable Trusts issued a report in January detailing how it is essential to reduce the complexity of the student loan repayment system. One recommendation includes allowing loan servicers to be temporarily permitted to enroll borrowers into an income-driven plan without requiring extensive paperwork.

Borrowers already expressed difficulties navigating the repayment system when the economy was functioning much better than it is now, according to Pew.

The risks are high for failing to repay student loans. Borrowers "can face collection fees; wage garnishment; money being withheld from income tax refunds, Social Security, and other federal payments; damage to their credit scores; and even ineligibility for other aid programs, such as help with homeownership," Pew noted.

Going forward, Biden has proposed forgiving up to \$10,000 in federal student loans for borrowers. But borrowers have no guarantees that such a change will take place or when.

Texas governor's hands-off approach to Covid-19 has allowed the virus to thrive

When Brittany Bankhead-Kendall received the Covid-19 vaccine in a beautiful executive boardroom at University Medical Center in Lubbock, Texas, the small jab finally gave her a dose of hope that she and her family would be safe.

But she still knew that downstairs, patients were fighting for their lives and dying every day, relying on surgical tubes and ventilators just to breathe.

"It's a huge juxtaposition, and it's a really precarious situation to have so much hope and so much heartache, kind of, all in the same walls," said Bankhead-Kendall, a trauma surgeon and ICU doctor with the Texas Tech University Health Sciences

A year into the pandemic, more than 13,500 Covid-19 patients are languishing in hospitals across Texas. With only 586 ICU beds left statewide and some regions already running out of space, "hospitals can't take much more", the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) recently tweeted.

Yet Covid is still raging: about one in six molecular tests in Texas comes back positive right now, well over the 10% threshold Greg Abbott, the state's Republican governor, once viewed as a "warning flag" for high community spread.

"The Covid-19 pandemic is at its worst in Texas," DSHS wrote online earlier this month, and "it's likely never been easier to catch".

In a perfect world, Bankhead-Kendall said, Texas would take a page from other states, where leaders have strategically used economic shutdowns to give healthcare workers a break.

"If you're not gonna be in our hospitals, helping take care of our patients, then you can at least be outside our walls and doing your part to back off in other ways," she said.

But Abbott has categorically rejected another lockdown, a successful but blunt instrument that would undoubtedly cause him political grief. And, though he has instituted business occupancy reductions and bar closures in regions with high hospitalizations, those restrictions have proven half-baked and mostly ineffective.

In fact, other than championing therapeutic treatments and boasting about the state's vaccine rollout, Abbott's administration has made shockingly little effort to mitigate the virus's carnage in recent months, even as a new, highly contagious variant threatens further devastation.

"Republican politicians are acting like it's business as usual," said Abhi Rahman, communications director for the Texas Democratic party. "They're acting like the pandemic never existed in the first place."

Last March, Dan Patrick, Texas's lieutenant governor, stoked widespread backlash when he advocated for a swift reopening, insinuating that the nation's elderly were willing to put their lives on the line to save the US economy. But despite Texas's hasty emergence from lockdown in May, its struggling workforce has failed to bounce back, with the unemployment rate still lingering at 7.2% as of December, compared to 3.5% the year before.

Instead, Texas's hands-off approach has rallied the virus, killing more than 33,700 Texans, leaving children orphaned and forcing doctors to make painful decisions about rationing care. Now, after months of suffering, the pandemic has reached another hellish chapter, with hundreds dying daily.

"Elections have consequences, and this is the direct result of Republican leadership," Rahman said.

In Fort Worth, criminal justice organizer Pamela Young balked at the city's invitation to pile into a room for seven hours of face-to-face interview panels with the top candidates for police chief this January.

After witnessing near-constant, highprofile instances of police brutality in Fort Worth, she knows how much the police chief job matters. So she asked the deputy



city manager if he could facilitate a virtual option for the panels, similar to the remote meetings other local officials have been holding.

But the city insisted on in-person interviews, seemingly ambivalent to the fact that they were forcing Young to either put her life on the line or be boxed out of high-stakes conversations on an issue she had been advocating around for years.

"It's frightening to think that our city government and staff leadership – whatever – have such a disregard for human life in the midst of a global pandemic," Young said.

Other Texas cities and counties – especially urban hubs that lean more Democratic – have strayed from the state's example and tried to implement policies to curtail infections at the local level. But since last summer, Abbott and his colleagues have undermined other officials' authority, sabotaging attempts to save lives in hard-hit communities.

"The state is driving the car," explained the Houston mayor, Sylvester Turner. "We are passengers."

In December, Abbott – backed by Texas attorney general Ken Paxton – went so far as to encourage businesses in Austin to thwart a local curfew and ring in the new year late into the night.

Emboldened crowds gathered outside of open bars. Inside, revelers danced and hugged while bartenders went maskless, a deadly recipe for the surge upon a surge that health experts warned would happen if Americans didn't stay home for the holidays.

Meanwhile, Bankhead-Kendall has watched as patients who survived even mild or asymptomatic Covid-19 cases deal with collapsed lungs or blood clots, likely because of the virus.

Since the introduction of a vaccine, the general public in Texas has grown lax, she said, "feeling like it's almost over". But so far, only around 5% of the state's roughly 29 million residents have received at least a first dose, and widespread availability is still presumably months away.

"They don't understand the immediate or the potential long-term consequences or sequelae of the disease," Bankhead-Kendall said.

At 78 and the oldest president, Biden sees a world changed

WASHINGTON (AP) — When Joe Biden took the oath of office as the 46th president, he became not only the oldest newly inaugurated U.S. chief executive in history but also the oldest sitting president ever.

Biden was born Nov. 20, 1942, in Scranton, Pennsylvania. He was 78 years, two months and one day old when he was sworn in on Wednesday. That's 78 days older than President Ronald Reagan was when he left office in 1989.

A look at how the country Biden now leads has changed over his lifetime and how his presidency might reflect that.

BIGGER, MORE DIVERSE PIE

The U.S. population is approaching 330 million people, dwarfing the 135 million at Biden's birth and nearly 60% greater than when he was first elected to the Senate in 1972. The world population in Biden's lifetime has grown from about 2.3 billion to 7.8 billion.

More striking is the diversity in Biden's America. The descendant of Irish immigrants, Biden was born during a period of relative stagnant immigration after U.S. limitations on new entries in the 1920s, followed by a worldwide depression in the 1930s. But a wave of white European immigration followed World War II, when Biden was young, and more recently an influx of Hispanic and nonwhite immigrants

signed several immigrant-friendly executive orders.

BIDEN, HARRIS AND HISTORY

Biden took special note of Vice President Kamala Harris as the first woman elected to national office, and the first Black woman and south Asian woman to reach the vice presidency. "Don't tell me things can't change," he said of Harris, who was a student in the still-mostly segregated Oakland public elementary school when Biden became a senator.

The first time Biden addresses a joint session of Congress, there will be two women behind a president, another first: Harris and Speaker Nancy Pelosi, D-Calif. But change comes slowly. Harris was just the second Black woman ever to serve in the Senate. When she resigned Monday, the Senate was left with none -- and just three Black men out of 100 seats. Black Americans account for about 13% of the population.

MONEY MATTERS

Minimum wage in 1942 was 30 cents an hour. Median income for men according to the 1940 census, the last before Biden's birth, was \$956. Today, the minimum wage is \$7.25. The federal government's most recent weekly wage statistics reflect a median annual income of about \$51,100 for full-time workers. But the question is



class is charged annual tuition of more than \$73,000, or a year and almost five months of the median U.S. salary (and that's before taxes).

Biden proposes raising the minimum wage to \$15 an hour -- a move already drawing opposition from Republicans. He's called for tuition-free two-year community and technical college and tuition waivers for four-year public schools (so, not Harvard) for students from households with \$125,000 or less in annual income.

DEBT

National debt has soared in Biden's

\$72 billion to \$27 trillion. But it's a recent phenomenon. Biden finished 36 years in the Senate and became vice president amid the fallout from the 2008 financial crash, when the debt was about \$10 trillion. Now he takes office amid another economic calamity: the coronavirus pandemic.

To some degree, this is a biographical bookend for Biden. He was

Reflecting how President Franklin Roosevelt approached the Great Depression and World War II, Biden is nonetheless calling for an additional \$1.9 trillion in immediate deficit spending to prevent a

AUTOMOBILES

As part of his proposed overhaul of the energy grid, Biden wants to install 500,000 electric vehicle charging stations by 2030, a move analysts project could spur the sale of 25 million electric vehicles. For context, federal statistics counted 33 million cars in the U.S. altogether in 1948, as Biden began grammar school.

A FIRST FOR THE SILENT GENERATION

Biden is part of the Silent Generation, so named because it falls between the "Greatest Generation" that endured the Depression and won World War II, and their children, the Baby Boomers, who made their mark through the sweeping social and economic changes of the civil rights era, Vietnam and the Cold War.

True to the stereotypes, Biden's generation looked for decades as if it would never see one of its own in the Oval Office. The Greatest Generation produced John F. Kennedy, Lyndon Johnson, Richard Nixon, Gerald Ford, Jimmy Carter, Reagan and George H.W. Bush. Then Boomers took over. Bill Clinton, George W. Bush and Donald Trump were born in a span of 67 days in 1946, the first of the Boomer years. Barack Obama, born in 1961, bookended their generation as a young Boomer.

If his inaugural address is any indication, Biden seems eager to embrace the characteristics of his flanking generations. He ticked through the "cascading crises" -- a pandemic and economic fallout reminiscent of the Depression and subsequent war effort, a reckoning on race that's an extension of the civil rights era -- and summoned the nation "to the tasks of our time."

PLENTY OF FIRST-HAND LEARNING

Biden lived through 14 presidencies before beginning his own, nearly one-third of all presidents. No previous White House occupant had lived through so many administrations before taking office. Yahoo News BILL BARROW

As Trump departs office, reality sets in for QAnon cult

It began with a cryptic remark by President Trump at a photo op with senior military leaders in October 2017. "You guys know what this represents?" Trump asked the reporters he had summoned to the State Dining Room, gesturing to the officers arrayed beside him. "Maybe it's the calm before the storm."

No one, evidently including the generals in attendance, seemed to know what he meant. Was it a threat to North Korea? A warning to Iran or ISIS? Trump, and later his then press secretary Sarah Sanders, refused to elaborate. "He certainly doesn't want to lay out his game plan for our enemies," Sanders declared.

But within a few weeks an explanation for the remark began to take shape in the shadows of the internet, on a right-wing message board where someone who called himself Q — the designation for top-secret clearance from the Department of Energy, which supervises America's nuclear arsenal — began spinning out a baroque paranoid fantasy in elliptical, coded hints known as "crumbs." The core myth, elaborated over the next three years with contributions from a burgeoning cadre of followers, was that Trump was planning the destruction of a worldwide ring of Satanist pedophiles that included, in various versions, "deep state" bureaucrats, global financial elites, prominent Democrats and, inevitably, Jews.

Although there are theories about the identity of Q — none of which involve a top national security official — he or she remains anonymous, and so do most of Q's followers. Hence the name: QAnon.

The fantasy ended at noon on Jan. 20, when Joe Biden took the oath of office,

while the erstwhile QAnon hero, now just Donald Trump, ex-president, skulked off to his estate in Florida without even a Twitter account to his name.

For some the charade had ended two weeks earlier, with the chaotic riot at the Capitol, at which Q followers were well represented, that failed to stop the counting of electoral votes certifying Biden's victory. Or at various other milestones along the tortuous road that led from the Nov. 3 election. Q had gone mostly silent since then, and followers had to fall back on reassuring each other that Trump was just biding his time before unleashing the "Storm" on an ever-growing list of enemies, eventually including members of his own administration.

"Trust the Plan" was the mantra of true believers. "Just think," one posted hopefully on Jan. 19, "today and tomorrow will be holidays for your children."

But as the clock ticked down to noon on Wednesday, Q message boards began filling with increasingly desperate posts from followers who claimed to have gone without sleep for as long as six days, not wanting to miss the moment they had been waiting and hoping for for years. "Please God, I'm watching, it's making me sick to my stomach, but I want to see arrests," one wrote. "Either arrests happen or we are now China's property," wrote another. And as Biden prepared to take the oath, a few minutes before 12 p.m. ET, despair turned to anger, even at Trump himself. "Thanks Trump!" read one post. "You sold out our country!"

In what will probably be the closest thing to an official conclusion to the Q saga, Ron Watkins, the former administrator of the 8kun board, which hosted Q, posted

a conciliatory message to Telegram shortly after Biden's inauguration ceremony, telling followers, "we keep our chins up and go back to our lives as best we are able."


"We have a new president sworn in and it is our responsibility as citizens to respect the Constitution regardless of whether or not we agree with the specifics or details regarding officials who are sworn in," the message continued. "As we enter into the

next administration please remember all the friends and happy memories we made together over the past few years."

In an effort to perhaps reassure followers that all is not completely lost, Watkins added, "I'll have more to say in a few days regarding a new project I'm currently fleshing out," before concluding the message with "God bless."

Watkins and his father, Jim, who owns 8kun, the anonymous message board that has hosted Q's posts for years, played an integral role in facilitating the QAnon phenomenon, leading some to suspect that the two were actually behind the Q persona — a theory both have previously denied.

On Election Day 2020, hours after Q posted what would end up being one of their last "drops," Ron Watkins announced he was stepping down as the administrator of 8kun. In the weeks that followed, he emerged as a prominent source of a wide range of baseless election-fraud conspiracy theories. His particularly aggressive promotion of false claims relating to Dominion Voting Systems earned him several appearances on the far-right-wing



One America News Network, an "expert witness" citation in one of Sidney Powell's unsuccessful "Kraken" lawsuits and a retweet from Trump.

It's too early to say where QAnon will rank in the long history of human delusion. Its reach was wide but comparatively shallow - compared, say, with the Heaven's Gate cult, whose three dozen or so members committed mass suicide in 1997, believing they would be transported to an alien spaceship tracking Comet Hale-Bopp as it approached Earth. Strong beliefs aren't necessarily shaken by failed prophecies. Armageddon has been confidently predicted innumerable times since the Book of Revelation was accepted into the biblical canon; in fact, in 1971, the psychic Jeane Dixon pegged it for 2020, which must have seemed safe enough at the time. Now evidently leaderless, and with its raison detre gone, QAnon may have nowhere to go. But its legacy will endure, a testament to human gullibility and the powerful urge to channel outrage against an enemy, even an imaginary one.

Is an animated Game of Thrones series in the offing?

Game of Thrones, based on novels by George R.R. Martin, became a global phenomenon and won 12 Emmy awards, including the top prize of best drama series.

The show ended its run on HBO in 2019. Executives have been working to develop new programming in the franchise as they compete with Walt Disney Co, Netflix Inc and others vying for streaming viewers.

King of Thailand Reportedly Accused of Breaking Sister's Ankles After She Questions Plan to Name Second Queen

The unpredictable King of Thailand, Maha Vajiralongkorn, who is suffering mass protests in Bangkok, has now been accused of breaking his sister's ankles.

The shocking allegation was reported by Andrew MacGregor Marshall, the former Reuters bureau chief in Bangkok, in his subscription-only newsletter, Secret Siam.

Marshall, who is free to quote his Thai sources without fear of the country's vicious censorship laws since he left Asia, reports that the king is alleged to have attacked his sister after she was knocked over by his dogs. Insiders claimed that he either jumped on her legs or beat her with a cane.

The assault was allegedly prompted after she confronted him over his plans to make his official consort a second queen, alongside his present wife, Queen Suthida. The Thai nobility has recently been alive with rumors that King Maha X is set to elevate his official consort, Sineenat "Koi" Wongvajirapakdi, to the status of full queen.

The proposed scheme apparently went down badly with his sister, Princess Sirindhorn, who went to see her brother to try to change his mind about two weeks ago.

This appears to have been a bad idea; the palace recently announced that Sirindhorn had injured both of her ankles in a fall, and had been taken to the hospital, but, MacGregor Marshall says, citing "well-placed sources" in "informed palace networks," that this is less than half the story.

In fact, he alleges, "a furious row erupted" during the meeting and "she was knocked over by one of Vajiralongkorn's dogs, and

while she was lying on the ground he either stamped on her ankles or struck them with a cane, shattering both of them."

MacGregor Marshall says that Sirindhorn underwent operations on both ankles at Chulalongkorn Hospital and is unlikely to walk again for several months.

An announcement on Koi's promotion to Thailand's second queen is said to have been planned for Tuesday, her birthday. In what may be a precursor to an official announcement later, the pair made a public appearance wearing matching blue coats as they released fish and birds in a Buddhist ceremony at Wasukri pier in Bangkok. Contrary to a report in German newspaper Bild, an official announcement of her elevation has not yet been made.

If Koi is indeed promoted to the position of queen, it would mark a remarkable comeback for the 35-year-old former nurse

Koi was only released from detention in August last year after spending ten months at a correctional facility. She had been accused of feuding with the queen but was then declared "untainted" and restored to her role as 68-year-old King Maha Vajiralongkorn's official consort.

Just as rumors of her release were circulating, over a thousand photos of her, including alleged nudes, were sent on SD cards to MacGregor Marshall, and to Pavin Chachavalpongpun, a Thai academic and outspoken critic of the monarchy.

The king only married his current and fourth wife, Suthida, in May 2019, just days before his coronation. He divorced his third wife in 2014. The relationship was made famous by a leaked video show-

ing her feeding birthday cake to his poodle, Fufu, while she wore only a G-string and courtiers crawled on the floor before her and the king.

Fufu featured in a previous embarrassing incident: Cables written by Eric John when he was U.S. ambassador to Bangkok, which were published by Wikileaks, detailed the king's strange obsession with the dog. The diplomatic

cables said he adored Fufu, and gave him the title air chief marshal. He is said to have brought the dog to an official dinner "dressed in formal evening attire complete with paw mitts" where he drank from guests' water glasses.

Thailand is battling a deep recession brought about by COVID-19 and the collapse of the pivotal tourist trade.

Opponents of the ultra-rich royal family have been emboldened in recent months as rallies by student protesters against the establishment have seen their numbers swelling.

Demonstrators have recently taken to protesting by wearing crop tops exposing their midriff to mock the king, who has been photographed wearing similar garb at airports and in German shopping

The protests have been inflamed by reports of the king's vast wealth, estimated by London's Financial Times at between \$30 billion and \$40 billion, after sovereign funds were effectively put under his direct control by the leaders of a successful 2014 coup.



He is believed to be the world's richest king.

As The Daily Beast recently reported, Vajiralongkorn is also alleged to have built up an extraordinary fleet of 38 jets and helicopters for the exclusive use of the Thai royal family.

He has spent much of the past few years living in Germany, most recently at the Grand Hotel Sonnenbichl in Garmish-Partenkirchen, where his retinue of 20 concubines, who have all been given the same honorary surname, have also damaged his domestic and international reputation.

Email addresses provided on Thai government websites did not work, with emails from The Daily Beast requesting comment bouncing back. However, the Thai royals do not typically comment in response to press inquiries, in part because criticizing the royal family in the media is an offense under strict lèse majesté provisions of Thai law.

Pakistan PM angry over reports TV anchor knew about strike

ISLAMABAD (AP) — Pakistan's prime minister reacted angrily Monday to media reports of a text exchange between an Indian TV anchor and a former media industry executive that suggests a 2019 Indian airstrike inside Pakistan was designed to boost Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's chances for reelection.

Imran Khan took to Twitter to respond to Indian media reports of an exchange on the WhatsApp messaging service between popular Indian TV anchor Arnab Goswami and Partho Dasgupta, the former head of a TV rating company.

The purported text exchange three days before the airstrike indicates Goswami had prior knowledge of the attack and that it was designed to drum up support for Modi in his reelection bid in pending parliamentary elections.

Goswami, a firebrand anchor who is Indian Republic TV's co-owner and editor in chief, is known for supporting Modi and his nationalist policies.

According to the WhatsApp chat transcript, Goswami texted Dasgupta three days before the Feb. 26, 2019 airstrike, saying "something big will happen" and "On Pakistan the government is confident of striking in a way that people will be elated."

Dasgupta tells Goswami the attack on Pakistan would give Modi a "sweeping majority" in the upcoming general election. Months later, Modi surged to a landslide victory in May 2019, propelling his Hindu nationalist party to back-to-back majorities in parliament.

Neither Dasgupta nor Goswami was available for comment Monday. But Goswami's Republic TV issued a statement alleging the Pakistani government was conspiring against his station.

The February 2019 airstrike on Pakistan followed a suicide bombing in the Indian-controlled portion of Kashmir that month that killed more than 40 Indian soldiers. India blamed Pakistan-based militant group Jaish-e-Mohammed, which claimed responsibility.

Although Pakistan detained Jaish-e-Mohammed's leaders, Modi's government launched a nighttime airstrike on the Pakistani town of Balakot, saying it hit a militant camp. Pakistan said Indian warplanes dropped bombs in a forested area, causing no casualties.

Khan alleged in a speech at the U.N. in 2019 that Modi used the airstrike "for domestic electoral gains."


Khan in a series of tweets urged the world community to "stop India from its reckless, militarist agenda before the Modi govt's brinkmanship pushes our region into a conflict it cannot control."

Pakistan and India have routinely accused each other of unprovoked attacks along the tense Kashmir frontier in violation of a 2003 cease-fire agreement. Kashmir is split between the nuclear-armed rivals, and both claim it in its entirety. They have fought two wars over the region since their independence from British colonial rule in 1947.

The text exchange controversy also drew criticism from India's opposition, which

demanded answers from Modi.

The opposition Congress Party said the text exchange between



Shashi Tharoor, a Congress Party lawmaker, said Sunday the "leaking of military secrets to a TV channel for its commercial purposes" required a "serious inquiry" by the Modi government. "We all expect it won't, given the evidence of its complicity in the betrayals revealed," Tharoor wrote on Twitter.



The U.S. Deported The Man Who Would Become China's 'Father of Space Technology' Out of Fear

America may not have won World War II and landed on the moon later if not for the contributions of a brilliant Chinese scientist named Qian Xuesen. Fearing communist presence after the war, the U.S., however, deported Qian to China, clueless that he would eventually spearhead programs that would target American troops and eventually propel China into space. Born to well-educated parents in 1911, it was evident from an early age that Qian had superior intellect. He graduated at the top of his class at Shanghai Jiao Tong University and won a scholarship at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). Qian arrived in Boston in 1935. He eventually moved to the California Institute of Technology (CalTech) to study under Hungarian aeronautical engineer Theodore von Karman, one of the field's most influential at the time. It was in CalTech when Qian became a member of a group of innovators called Suicide Squad, which aimed to build a rocket on campus. They earned their nickname, however, due to botched experiments involving volatile chemicals. Just before World War II, the U.S. military, which had been paying for research into jet propulsion systems, caught wind of the Suicide Squad. In 1943, the Jet Propulsion

Lab was established under von Karman -and Qian was at its core. Qian, a national of the Republic of China (ROC; now Taiwan) -- then a U.S. ally -- was given security clearance to work on classified weapons research. At the end of the war, he was among the world's leading experts in jet propulsion, even flying to Germany as a lieutenant colonel to gather intelligence from Nazi engineers. Unfortunately, Qian's American career faltered when Mao Zedong established the communist People's Republic of China (PRC) in 1949. Chinese nationals were then seen as a threat to the U.S. The FBI accused Qian of being a communist based on a 1938 document, which showed that he had attended a social gathering of the Pasadena Communist Party. He denied being a member, but research proved that he joined the group with JPL co-founder Frank Malina, who was also part of the Suicide Squad. Qian's membership was more inspired by anti-racism than Marxism, however. For instance, they campaigned against the segregation of the local Pasadena swimming pool. Despite the absence of evidence that he actually spied for the PRC, Qian was put on house arrest for five years. In 1955, President Eisenhower deported him to China. Qian left America by boat with his wife and two U.S.-born children. He vowed never to return again. The scientist arrived as a promising talent in China. However, he was not immediately welcomed into the CCP, since his wife was the daughter of a ROC leader. Qian was admitted to the CCP in 1958, later serving on its Central Committee. In the following years, he oversaw the launch of the first Chinese satellite into space -- and a multitude

of other projects that laid the foundations of China's Lunar Exploration Program. In a slap of irony, a missile program Qian helped develop produced weapons that were fired back at the U.S. These were silkworm missiles fired at Americans in the Gulf War of 1991, as well as the USS Mason by Huti rebels in Yemen in 2016. "So there's this odd circularity. The US expelled this expertise, and it has come back to bite them," said Fraser Macdonald, author of "Escape from Earth: A Secret History of the Space Rocket," according to BBC News. Despite the turnaround of his



life, Qian reportedly remained fond of the American people. In 2002, Frank Marble, a CalTech colleague, stated that Qian had "lost faith in the American government" but "always had very warm feelings for the American people," according to The New York Times. Qian died as an accomplished scientist at the age of 98 in Beijing. He has since been revered as a hero in China. Feature Images via CCTV YahooNews **Editorial Staff**

Pakistan loses four spots in corruption perceptions ranking: report

Pakistan ranked 124 out of 180 countries — dropping four spots over last year — in the newly released Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI) by Transparency International, an annual index that ranks countries based on perceptions of public sector corruption. The 2020 edition of the CPI ranked 180 countries and territories by their perceived levels of public sector corruption, drawing on 13 expert assessments and surveys of business executives.

Denmark and New Zealand topped the index this year, with 88 points each. Syria, Somalia and South Sudan are at the bottom of the chart with 14, 12 and 12 points, respectively.

Last year, Pakistan had ranked 120. On a scale of 0-100, with zero being 'Highly Corrupt' and 100 being 'Very Clean', the country's corruption score stands at 31 — a point lower than last year's 32 indicating that the perception of corruption in the public sector has worsened slightly.

A reason behind the drop in Pakistan's score on CPI list was its points in the 'Rule of Law Index'


and 'Varieties of Democracy' (VDem) categories were lower than last year.

The questions asked by World Justice Programme (WJP) regarding 'Rule of Law Index' and 'Varieties of Democracy' are about the corruption of government officials viz legislatures, executives, judiciary, police and military, explained Sohail Muzaffar, the chairman of Pakistan's chapter of Transparency International.

The government has to improve its performance in these four sectors, he emphasised.

The increase in corruption perception comes despite the extraordinary efforts of the National Accountability Bureau (NAB) which claims to have recovered Rs363 billion in the last two years and the Public Accounts Committee, which claims to have recovered Rs300 billion over the same period, noted Muzaffar.

Meanwhile, corruption perceptions in other countries in the region including India (40 points), Iran (25 points) and Bangladesh (26 points)



improved, even if by small margins. Afghanistan's score (19) has also improved by three points and so did Turkey (40), according to CPI's statistics.

China, with a score of 42, ranks 78 on the list.

In 2020, the CPI focused on the impact of corruption on the response to the Covid-19 pandemic and found that persistent corruption not only undermines healthcare systems but also contributes to democratic backsliding. Countries that performed well on the index generally invest more in healthcare and, therefore, are in a better position to provide coverage to all their

citizens. They are also less likely to violate democratic norms and institutions or the rule of law, the report said.

Commenting on the findings, chair of Transparency International, Delia Ferreira Rubio, said: "The past year has tested governments like no other in memory, and those with higher levels of corruption have been less able to meet the challenge. But even those at the top of the CPI must urgently address their role in perpetuating corruption at home and abroad."

Indian siblings rescued by NGO after locking themselves in filthy room for a decade

Three Indian siblings who locked themselves inside a single room for a decade after the death of their mother are slowly re-adjusting to normal life.

The trio, aged between 30 and 42, had been using the floor of the downtown room in the city of Rajkot, which had no natural sunlight, as a toilet and were living among piles of rubbish.

Overcoming the smell, volunteers from the Saathi Seva Group NGO broke down the door of the room on December 28 after a tip-off from the siblings' distressed father, Navin Mehta, 85, who said he had lost hope of the trio ever emerging on their own accord.

Mr Mehta said he had been bringing them food every day and leaving it outside the room but was too scared to enter himself as he believed he would be exposed to black magic.

Ambrish, 42, the eldest of the siblings, was described as "skeletal" and unable to stand after sitting cross-legged for weeks, while the other brother, Bhavesh, 34, was suffering from memory loss.

The sister, Meghna, 39, was the only one clothed when the group was found and said she had been cooking for her brothers using the supplies left at the house by Mr Mehta.

"They may be like what their father says [that they are mentally ill], but they need treatment urgently," said Jalpa Patel, the leader of the team from the Saathi Seva Group, which usually works with members of the homeless community in Rajkot.

"Megha claimed she was alright but kept on asking for food every now and then. She seemed to be disoriented. Bhavesh wasn't talking yesterday when we managed to break into their room. However, on Monday, he started speaking in limited sentences," said Ms Patel.

Mr Mehta said the siblings were well-educated and had

degrees in economics, law, and psychology but his wife's death had "affected my children deeply" and that "some relatives did black magic on them."

The trio were first cleaned and shaved, before being taken for psychological assessment at a government hospital in Rajkot.

The Earth is spinning faster now than at any time in the past half century

If 2020 felt like a drag, you may be surprised to discover it actually went faster than you thought ... and this year is set to be even speedier.

The Earth has been spinning unusually quickly lately, and July 19 saw the shortest day since records began, with the planet completing its rotation in 1.4602 milliseconds less than the usual 86,400 seconds.

The previous shortest day in 2005 was beaten 28 times last year, and 2021 is on track to be the most nippy year ever, with the average day passing 0.5 milliseconds faster than usual.

The changes to the length of a standard day were only discovered after highly accurate atomic clocks were developed in the 1960s and compared to fixed stars in the sky.

In recent decades, Earth's average rotational speed has consistently decreased and timekeepers have been forced to add 27 leap seconds to atomic time since the 1970s to keep clocks in sync with the slowing planet.

The last one was added on New Year's Eve 2016, when clocks around the world paused for a second to allow the Earth's rotation to catch up.

Then, BT's speaking clock added a second's pause before its third pip while Radio 4 inserted an extra pip to its 1am bulletin.

However, now the planet is speeding up and a negative leap second may soon be needed so atomic clocks can align correctly with the turning world.

It would be the first time that a second has been removed from global clocks.

Peter Whibberley, senior research scientist with National Physical Laboratory's time and frequency group, said: "It is certainly correct that the Earth is spinning faster now than at any time in the last 50 years.

"It's quite possible that a negative leap second will be needed if the Earth's rotation rate increases further, but it's too early to say if this is likely to happen.

"There are also international discussions taking place about the future of leap seconds, and it's also possible that the need for a negative leap second might push the decision towards ending leap seconds for good."

On Sunday, the solar day lasted just 23 hours, 59 minutes and 59.9998927 seconds, then slowed down on Monday to a little more than 24 hours.

However, in the course of 2021, atomic clocks are expected to accumulate a lag of about 19 milliseconds.

While it would take hundreds of years for the difference to become obvious to most people, modern satellite communication and navigation systems rely on time being consistent with the conventional positions of the Sun, Moon and stars.

It is the task of scientists and officials at the International Earth Rotation Service, based in Paris, to monitor the



planet's rotation and inform countries when leap seconds must be added or taken away six months in advance.

However, there can be consequences of tinkering with time.

When a leap second was added in 2012, Mozilla, Reddit, Foursquare, Yelp, LinkedIn and StumbleUpon all reported crashes and there were problems with the Linux operating system and programmes written in the programming language Java.

Some countries want to move to atomic time completely, and abolish leap second corrections, but the UK is opposed to the move because it would sever the link with solar time forever.

The World Radiocommunication Conference will decide on the fate of the leap second in 2023.

The speed of the Earth's rotation varies constantly because of the complex

motion of its molten core, oceans and atmosphere, as well as the effect of celestial bodies such as the Moon.

The friction of the tides and the change in distance between the Earth and the Moon all make for daily variations in the speed the planet rotates on its axis.

Even the snow building up on mountains and melting in the summer can shift the rotation.

Global warming will also have an effect by melting ice and snow at higher elevations, causing the Earth to spin faster, although only by a small amount.

If your goal for Tuesday is a 30-minute workout at the gym, but you only squeeze in 10 minutes, feel grateful for that. It's enough. Maybe tomorrow will be better.

Korma Procedure:

Dry roast dessicated coconut, peanuts, poppy seeds(khus khus), blend them all and make a fine paste of all.

Take a pan, heat it and add the sliced onions, smear 1 tsp oil all over the onions and slightly roast them for about two minutes and make a paste of it too.

Now, in a curry cooking vessel or pot, add oil, add ginger garlic paste, add green chillies or add paste of it.

Saute well and add the paste of coconuts, peanuts, poppy seeds and onion paste. Mix and cook the masala for two to three minutes.

Add salt, red chilli powder and cook the mixture until oil leaves the masala. If the masala paste sticks to the base then add very little water in order to avoid the

burning of masala. Add beaten yogurt, mix it well and again cook the whole korma until the masala is cooked well and also the oil should start leaving the masala. It takes about 15 minutes for the masala to cook well on sim flame. Finally, add the cooked chicken curry into the Korma and mix well. Add little water if you find the gravy too thick.

Add the garam masala powder, coriander leaves, mint leaves and let it cook for about five - ten minutes.

Switch off the flame and serve hot. Tastes best when served with Pulao or Bagara Khana.

Notes

1. Whenever we add nutty ingredients like almonds or cashews or coconut or peanuts or poppy seeds, it is better to dry roast them and make a paste of it.2. The curries taste much better by doing so.3.Cook the



masala on sim flame as the masala may stick to the bottom and may burn and spoils the Korma taste.4.Add little water if the masala sticks the base.5. Always add coriander and mint leaves in making any Korma as they enhance and better the taste of the Korma.6.Also few more dry spices like coriander powder or cumin seeds powder can be added if one would wish to.7. The dish can also be garnished with fried onions.

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 350°F (177°C) and grease a 9×13 inch pan.

Make the cake: Mash the bananas. I usually just use my mixer for this! Set mashed bananas aside.

Whisk the flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, and salt together. Set

Using a handheld or stand mixer fitted

with a paddle attachment, beat the butter on high speed until smooth and creamy - about 1 minute. Add both sugars and beat on high speed for 2 minutes until creamed together. Scrape down the sides and up the bottom of the bowl with a rubber spatula as needed. Add the eggs and the vanilla. Beat on medium-high speed until combined, then beat in the mashed bananas. Scrape down the sides and up the bottom of the bowl as needed. With the mixer on low speed, add the dry ingredients in three additions alternating with the buttermilk and mixing each addition just until incorporated. Do not overmix. The batter will be slightly thick and a few lumps is OK. Spread batter into the prepared pan. Bake for 45-50 minutes. Baking times vary, so keep an eye on yours. The cake is done when a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. If you find the top of the cake is browning too quickly in the oven, loosely cover it with alumi-

Remove the cake from the oven and set on a wire rack. Allow to cool completely. After about 45 minutes, I usually place it in the refrigerator to speed things up. Make the frosting: In a large bowl using a handheld or stand mixer fitted with a paddle or whisk attachment, beat the cream cheese and butter together on high speed until smooth and creamy. Add 3 cups confectioners' sugar, vanilla, and salt. Beat on low speed for 30 seconds, then switch to high speed and beat for 2 minutes. If you want the frosting a little thicker, add the extra 1/4 cup of confectioners sugar (I add it). Spread the frosting on the cooled cake. Refriger-



ate for 30 minutes before serving. This helps sets the frosting and makes cutting

Cover leftover cake tightly and store in the refrigerator for 5 days.

Notes

Make Ahead Instructions: Prepare cake through step 5. Cover the cake tightly and refrigerate for up to 2 days or freeze up to 3 months. Bring to room temperature, make the frosting, frost, and serve. Frosted cake freezes well, up to 3 months. Thaw overnight in the refrigerator, bring to room temperature or serve cold.

Buttermilk: Buttermilk is required for this recipe. You can make your own DIY version of buttermilk if needed. Add 1 Tablespoon of white vinegar or lemon juice to a liquid measuring cup. Then add enough room temperature whole milk to the same measuring cup until it reaches 1 and 1/2 cups. (In a pinch, lower fat or nondairy milks work for this soured milk, but the cake won't taste as

moist or rich.) Stir it around and let sit for 5 minutes. The homemade "buttermilk" will be somewhat curdled and ready to use in the recipe.

Cupcakes: I've gotten a few questions about turning this cake into cupcakes. For about 2 dozen cupcakes, fill the cupcake liners halfway and bake for about 20-22 minutes. Same oven temperature. Bundt Cake: You can bake this batter in a 10-12 cup bundt pan, but I find it's not quite as moist when baked in the bundt shape. Bake for 50-65 minutes, give or take. Use a toothpick to determine doneness. Same oven temperature.

Layer Cake: I use this recipe to make my banana layer cake. If you want to make a 2 layer cake, divide batter between 2 greased 9-inch cake pans, and bake at 350°F (177°C) for 26-30 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes

Siraj shines Down Under; family members, well-wishers rejoice in Hyderabad

Hyderabad: Mohammed Siraj's late father had always dreamt of watching his son play the trade at the highest level but as luck would have it, the wish remained unfulfilled as he died weeks before his son's Test debut in Australia, where the pacer emerged as the highest wicket-taker for India. "Continuously, we were watching from the day 1 when Siraj made his debut. We were all excited to see him play for India and happy that he did well and justified his selection," Ismail said.

"We have not planned any celebration at home, but the people of the society and the city of Hyderabad are going to celebrate."

"We did not expect that Siraj bhai would do so well. Such was his performance. He took five wickets. India has won the series in Australia. It"s a great thing to win the series in Australia with senior players out with injuries," said Shafi, who used to play tennis ball cricket with Siraj.

Shafi said he spoke to Siraj a few days ago and tried to motivate him to take more



wickets.

This was after officials at the park spent three years and over \$1 million converting the park's light

Rim is currently the dark sky-friendly portion of the park, visitors can travel to the remote Desert View or

North America to see the Milky Way Galaxy. Remember, these places only show the galaxy in the summer months, though. So, before you make a trip out to one of these places for this purpose, check to see when the Milky Way is at its brightest overhead.

Teotihuacan Pyramids

Teotihuacan is an ancient Mesoamerican city located 30 miles (50 km) northeast of modern-day Mexico City. The city, which was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987, was settled as early as 400 B.C. and became the most powerful and influential city in the region by 400 A.D. By the time the Aztecs found the city in the 1400s and named it Teotihuacan (meaning "the place where the gods were created"), the city had been abandoned for centuries. Teotihuacan's origins, history, and culture largely remain a mystery.

Teotihuacan Pyramids

Teotihuacan (also written Teotihuacán) is arranged in a grid layout that covers about 8 square miles (20 square kilometers). It contains around 2,000 single-story apartment compounds, as well as various pyramids, plazas, temples and palaces of nobles and priests.

The main buildings of Teotihuacan are connected by the Avenue of the Dead (or Miccaotli in the Aztec language Nahuatl). The Avenue of the Dead is a 130-foot-(40-meter-) wide, 1.5-mile- (2.4-km-) long road that's oriented slightly east (15.5 degrees) of true north and points directly at the nearby sacred peak of Cerro Gordo, an extinct volcano.

The city contains several large, important structures: The Pyramid of the Moon, the Pyramid of the Sun, the Ciudadela ("Citadel") and the Temple of Quetzalcoatl (the Feathered Serpent).

Pyramid of the Sun

Surrounded by smaller pyramids and platforms, the Pyramid of the Moon is situated at the northern end of the Avenue of the Dead and faces south. Standing at 140-feet (43-meters) high with a base measuring 426 by 511 feet (130 by 156 meters), the Pyramid of the Moon is the second largest structure in Teotihuacan.

Less than half a mile south of the Pyramid of the Moon stands the largest structure in Teotihuacan, the Pyramid of the Sun. Facing west, the pyramid stands at 216 feet (66 meters) with a base measuring approximately 720 by 760 feet (220 by 230 meters).

The Ciudadela is situated at the south end of the Avenue of the Dead. The 38-acre (15-hectare) courtyard contains multiple elite residential complexes and is dominated by the Temple of Quetzalcoatl, a kind of truncated pyramid that is adorned with numerous stone heads of the Feathered Serpent deity.

Who Built Teotihuacan? It's unknown who built the ancient city.

Scholars once believed the ancient Toltec civilization may have built the massive city, based largely on colonial period texts. But the Toltec culture (900-1150 A.D.) flourished hundreds of years after Teotihuacan peaked.

Other scholars believe the Totonacs, a tribe from the east, built and inhabited the city.

Another theory holds that immigrants flooded into the Teotihuacan valley following the eruption of a volcano, and those immigrants built or augmented the city. Teotihuacan appears to contain features of various cultures, including the Maya, Mixtec and Zapotec.

Whatever the case, Teotihuacan was founded as early as 400 B.C., though the largest structures of the city weren't completed until about 300 A.D.

It's thought that the city reached its peak around 100 years later, with a population as high as 200,000 people.

Teotihuacan Religion

Little is known about the language, politics, culture and religion of the Teotihuacan people. They had a glyph-based written language, but it may have been limited to dates and names.

The art and architecture of the city shows it was a polytheistic society, with the primary deity being the Great Goddess of Teotihuacan, which is depicted as a spider goddess. Other deities include Quetzalcoatl (a vegetation god whose meaning changed in subsequent civilizations), the rain god Tlaloc, and the god of spring Xipe Totec, among others.

The Teotihuacan priests practiced ritual sacrifices of animals and people to these gods.

In 1989, researchers discovered 18 sacrificial victims buried in a long pit just south of the Temple of Quetzalcoatl. The later discovered that around 200 other victims were sacrificed when the temple was built in the early 3rd century A.D. Many of these sacrifices were male warriors in military attire, others were young women and others still were males likely of relatively high social status.

More recently, in 2004, archaeologists uncovered evidence of sacrifices at the Pyramid of the Moon that suggests the site was a place to celebrate state power and militarism.

These sacrifices included 12 people with their hands bound behind their back, 10 of whom were decapitated and tossed about at the burial vault within the pyramid. The other two sacrifices were richly ornamented.

Other sacrifices at the pyramid include five canines (wolves or coyotes), three felines (jaguar or puma) and 13 birds (many thought to be eagles)—animals believed to be symbols of warriors.

Teotihuacan Influence

Artifacts found in the city and sites across Mexico suggest Teotihuacan was a wealthy trade metropolis in its prime.

In particular, the city exported fine obsidian tools, including spear and dart heads. Teotihuacan had a monopoly on obsidian trade—the most important deposit in Mesoamerica was located near the city.



Ceramics, such as pottery and other luxury goods, were also highly prized export goods because of their elaborate decorations. Other goods coming into and out of the city likely included cotton, cacao and exotic feathers and shells, among other things.

Local harvests included beans, avocados, peppers and squash, and the city farmers raised chickens and turkeys.

The art and architecture styles of Teotihuacan are found widely throughout Mesoamerica, suggesting the city had farreaching influence.


Teotihuacan Collapse It's unclear why Teotihuacan collapsed.

Around 600 A.D., major buildings were deliberately burned and artworks and religious sculptures were destroyed, suggesting an uprising from the poor against the ruling elite.

Another theory holds that invaders sacked and burned it-though Teotihuacan exerted its military power over other cultures, the city lacked fortifications and military structures.

By 750 A.D., the remaining inhabitants of the city had all abandoned their homes to join neighboring cultures or return to their ancestral homes.

Ongoing Research



By late 2015, they had unearthed 75,000 artifacts of various type, including seashells, pottery, animal bones and human skin. They also uncovered a large chamber containing vast amount of jewelry and other treasures, such as amber jars, black stone statues and other ritual relics.

Biden freezes giant UAE jet package, Saudi arms for review

US President Joe Biden's administration has temporarily frozen for review a massive package of F-35 jets to the United Arab Emirates and arms to Saudi Arabia, officials said on Wednesday.

The nearly week-old administration has already signalled it plans to end support for the Saudi-led, UAE-backed offensive in Yemen, which is facing a humanitarian catastrophe.

A State Department spokesperson said the administration is "temporarily pausing the implementation" of a number of defence sales "to allow incoming leadership an opportunity to review".

"This is a routine administrative action typical to most any transition, and demonstrates the administration's commitment to transparency and good governance," the spokesperson said. continue its normalisation with Israel, which Trump

The move is also aimed at "ensuring US arms sales meet our strategic objectives of building stronger, interoperable and more capable security partners".

The most high-profile sale is a \$23 billion package of top-of-the-line F-35 jets to the

Former president Donald Trump's administration agreed to the sale — the first of the stealth-capable planes to an Arab nation — after the UAE agreed to recognise Israel

A potential halt to the sale could raise questions about whether the UAE will

continue its normalisation with Israel, which Trump saw as a key foreign policy achievement.

Lawmakers of Biden's Democratic Party had voiced misgivings over the deal, fearing it would set off an arms race, but failed in the Senate to block the sale while Trump was in office.

The package to the UAE also included unarmed drones, while the United States has been preparing major sales of munitions to Saudi Arabia.

Trump had explicitly backed arms sales on commercial grounds, saying that the



Saudis were creating US jobs by buying from US manufacturers.

Secretary of State Antony Blinken said during his confirmation hearing that the Saudi offensive against Yemen's Huthi rebels, who are backed by Iran, has contributed to the dire humanitarian situation in Yemen

In an exclusive interaction with ETimes, the songstress opens up about her journey in the music industry, her take on remixes, and the much talkedabout Covid controversy. Excerpts: From 'Junni' to 'Jugni 2.0', how would you describe your musical journey? I feel lucky and blessed that all the hard work has paid off. I started out at the age of 12 and what a journey it has been! When I performed on the All India Radio as a child artiste, I realised that I wanted to get into music professionally. I had also won one of the inter-school competitions in Lucknow. All this made me--a little girl from a conservative family--feel like a star. It gave me the confidence to believe that I could do something with my life. I did everything I could for many, many years but got my break almost 20 years later. It was challenging because I didn't come from a musical background; my father is a businessman. I think I'm still learning more and more about this job, every single day. 'Jugni' was a passion project and 'Jugni 2.0' was just making sure that the song was heard by the whole generation.

How did you brave the tough times in your career?

When an artiste claims that they have not faced rejection, they are lying to themselves. Rejection is a part of any field because not everyone is going to love your work and style of singing. Every singer has their own audience and we should really do the best that we can and leave the rest to the audience. Even I don't like all kinds of music; it changes from person to person. So yes, there have been a lot of rejections, and I'm sure that even in the future there will be, and it's okay. I have learnt from my rejections.

Your take on remixes?

Some are insane, some are pathetic. I am also doing them and I hope that the ones I do, I don't kill them because it's just ridiculous. They're picking up a beautiful Hemant Kumar song and killing it; it's not the best idea.

What kind of songs do you like? I love sad, Sufi songs. That's the genre of music that I listen to. I love qawwalis and meaningful lyrics. One of my personal favourites is 'Jugni'. It is something that I resonate with because of the meaning of the song. When I started singing, I didn't know the meaning of the song. And when I read the meaning of the song, I fell in love with it even more because I started seeing it in a different light. It means that at the end of the day, it is between you and God

And my second favourite song, sung by



me is, 'Baby doll'. I was dealing with a lot of trauma and going through several ups and downs in my personal life when I was offered the song. When I understood the meaning of 'Yeh duniya pittal di, Baby doll main sone di', I sang it with a vengeance, which is quite sad. But I sang it with all my heart and people connected with it. What were you going through when the Covid controversy erupted? I don't even know why the whole controversy happened. I'm a normal person; I did not go against the law. When I landed in India on March 9, there was no quarantine law, no checkups at the airport. So I went home and everything was fine. I went to see my parents in Lucknow because I had a week off. Obviously, if I had known that I was high-risk, I would have stayed

mother who is 92. There's no way I would even go near them, but I was with them the whole week. Thankfully, they were all okay. Nobody caught the virus from me. But it was something that shook me up badly because the whole nation hated me and called me all sorts of things. It was not very nice. But you live and learn. I learned a lot from it and I forgive them. What precautions are you taking what with the second wave in London? We are just not getting out and refraining from meeting anyone. We are taking as many precautions as we can but hopefully, I will be back in India soon. **E TIMES**
