Sabine Parish Leaders Against Litter-These community volunteers recently completed preparation of educational materials to be distributed to local schools as part of the Education for Children component of a larger educational program administered by the group. The task involved stuffing 2,000 bags with age appropriate litter information and activity sheets. These signs provide a summary of the state freshwater fishing regulations, as well as the Lunker Program requirements.
