The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

"The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity leads us to contemplate the mystery of God who unceasingly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and through love." – Pope Francis, May 27, 2018

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.


Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.

The Feast of the Visitation of Mary

Monday, May 31, 2021


This feast commemorates the three-month visit of Mary with her elderly cousin Elizabeth during Mary's pregnancy with Jesus and Elizabeth's with John the Baptist. The story appears in the first chapter of Luke's Gospel. It recounts Elizabeth's Spirit-filled greeting, acknowledging Mary as "the mother of my Lord," and Mary's beautiful response, the Magnificat, which begins, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord." Introduced by the Franciscans in 1263, the feast became universal in the 16th century.

Dispensation to be Lifted

The Dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation is lifted

effective June 5, 2021

The following are some of the notable liturgical guidelines. For a complete list, see the memo available at reconnecttoledo.org/liturgy

- Face Masks are not required
 - The personal decision by some members of the clergy or the faithful to continue wearing masks/facial coverings should be respected out of charity
- Seating will no longer be limited

Rows will not be limited/closed. According to pastoral need, a designated socially distanced area may be provided for those who prefer such seating.

- Holy water fonts will be filled
 - Holy Water stoops and fonts without filters, or fresh water access, will continue to be cleaned on a regular basis.
- The sign of peace may be resumed

The Sign of Peace does not necessarily imply physical touch with others. Some members of the faithful may still be reluctant to extend/receive a physical Sign of Peace and their preference for no physical contact should be respected.

- Holy Communion reception on the hand or tongue is the perogative of the communicant
- Hymnals may be used Hymnals, missalettes, worship aids, etc. may once again be utilized.
- Liturgical Ministers may be reinstated

 A full complement of liturgical ministers (altar servers, lectors, ushers, musicians, cantors, choirs) may be reinstated.

Pastors will continue to make every effort to keep the churches/chapels entrusted to their care are clean and safe.

Those who have a serious reason, the sick and infirmed as well as those with pre-existing conditions, those who are incapable of physically attending Mass, and those who care for someone who is immuno-compromised are exempt from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. They should, however, make every effort to watch a broadcast of Mass from their homes.
