Dear Parishioners,

After our experience with increased participation at Christmas, I have decided to suspend mass sign ups after this Sunday. The church is set to safely host 100 people, and thanks to a generous donation of one of our parish families, we have a professional disinfecting machine that makes disinfecting the church quick and easy after each use.

From now on, just come to the church observing the safety requirements - mask wearing, sanitizing hands, and keeping distance from those other than your household. The average attendance varies between 40-70 people each mass. If the attendance increases to the higher numbers that might cause safety concerns, we will restore the registration.

Although participation in mass is still not under canonical obligation, I hope and pray that those who are healthy will come and adore Christ-God among us in the Eucharistic celebration.
