

Believe - Speak - Receive

When Jesus fought Satan in the wilderness (Matthew 4) He used God's word as His weapon. He spoke the living word, believing that it was true and Satan could not argue or stand against God's word.

Matthew 18:18-19 Encourages us that whatever two agree on and bind on earth will be bound in Heaven and that it will be done by God the Father.

Further, Mark 11: 23-24 Says if we do not doubt in our heart, but believe the things that we say and believe that we receive them, we shall have them.

Therefore, whenever we and a faith partner agree together to bind and cast out sickness and infirmity we both must speak in faith believing God that what is asked is accomplished. All believing partners must agree that their speech will align with God's word. Conversations between faith partners should continue speaking as though what was asked is received as they build each others faith. At the very least, we can agree that "God's word says _____ and I believe God, who does not lie." We also continue speaking to the specific infirmity, reminding Satan that he is cast out and calling the infirmity healed, while praising God. The healing begins when we ask in faith. When it is completed we can truly testify to God's power and grace.

Remember Revelation 12:11 for salvation and healing: They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony. lcl
