- 1. All applicants must be affiliated with a state recognized EMS organization.
- 2. National Incident Management System (NIMS) ICS 700.b, 100.c, & 200.c courses. Online courses are available at no cost. Go to <a href="http://training.fema.gov/IS/NIMS.asp">http://training.fema.gov/IS/NIMS.asp</a> or you can find this link and Course application at <a href="http://www.kittitascountyems.org/training.htm">http://www.kittitascountyems.org/training.htm</a>. Copies of NIMS "Certificates of Completion" are required for acceptance into course. Applications may be submitted without certificates pending completion.

Priority given to complete applications and local EMS affiliations.

- 3. BLS Healthcare Provider Course. LISTED COURSE IS REQUIRED! Offered prior to course as per schedule and is required for all students. Included in course fee.
- 4. Must be at least 18 years of age.
- 5. EMT course applicants must have a high school diploma or GED (for state certification, not for course application).
- 6. Must have the physical strength and good health to perform the normal functions of an EMT or EMR.
- 7. Must pass required background checks for hospital clinical/field requirements (included in course cost)
- 8. Negative UA/12-point panel drug screening (included in course cost and made available after start of class).
- 9. Must have proof of required vaccinations at start of class See back of Training Application
- 10. Must have proof of health & liability insurance/coverage through agency or provided by student (<a href="http://www.hpso.com/">http://www.hpso.com/</a> example). Check with agency before purchasing.

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# QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTERING EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN or EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONDER TRAINING

Individuals applying for admission to a Washington State training course in Kittitas County must meet ALL the following requirements, or they will not be eligible to enroll in the course:

- 1. You must be 18 years of age at the beginning of the course.
- 2. You must have a high school diploma or GED (EMT only for certification, not to apply for training. Not required for EMR certification.). Copy not required for application.
- 3. You must have the physical strength to perform the normal functions of an EMS Provider.
- 4. You must have completed the National Incident Management System (NIMS) ICS 700b, 100c, and 200c courses.
- 5. You must attend the Healthcare Provider Course offered with the EMT/EMR Course.
- 6. You must be an active member of one of the following emergency medical service entities in the State of Washington to attend this course and become WA State certified following course completion:
  - a. Licensed provider of ambulance or aid service
  - b. Law enforcement agency or affiliated Search & Rescue group
  - c. Other affiliated EMS/trauma care service recognized by WA State DOH

## ADDITIONAL LOCAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL LEVELS OF TRAINING Required Immunizations & PPD/TB Test: REQUIRED AT START OF COURSE!!

- Influenza (between October 1 and March 31 yearly)
- Td or Tdap booster (within 10 years)
- MMR: 2 shot series at least one month apart or positive antibody titer
- Varicella: 2 shot series at least one month apart or positive antibody titer
- Documentation of Hep B Series or positive antibody titer (if just started series, contact EMS Office)
- 2 negative PPD/TB Test within twelve months of the first day of the hospital clinical or blood titer, or if TB test is positive, documentation of chest x-ray, treatment, and release to work in a healthcare setting.

### Required Screening:

- Background check with written approval (included in course cost and conducted by KCEMS Office).
- Negative UA/12-point panel drug screening (included in course cost and coordinated by KCEMS Office).

### Include the following attachments with this application or per arrangement:

- Proof of ICS 700b, 100c, 200c (if not provided for previous Training)
- Proof of required vaccinations and/or titers, and TB tests (See above. Application may be submitted pending receipt of documentation.). DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED AT START OF CLASS!
- Copy of driver's license or other photo identification.
- Copy of professional liability, health and accident insurance <u>if providing own insurance</u>. Contact Kittitas County EMS Division for information on obtaining training liability insurance. (<u>Application may be submitted pending approval into initial training course before obtaining this insurance</u>.)

#### Note:

- Priority admission is given to individuals associated with Kittitas County licensed or affiliated EMS agencies with <u>complete</u> applications.
- Completion of application does not guarantee admission to any course. You will be notified of course admission via phone or email. Email and cell phone is preferred method of communication.
- It is the student's responsibility to notify, Kittitas County EMS Division, of any documented or suspected learning disabilities or challenges prior to the course.
