### Food Plot 101: Fall Planting for Winter Forage

The first thing you need to ask yourself is: Do you want an Annual (single season) or a Perennial (comes back yearly). Once you have made your decision, you can make your selection on what you want to plant. If you decide to go with a brassica or brassica blend (Annual), be sure to only repeat in the same area for 2 years. Brassica's take a lot of nitrogen and need a pH level above 6.3 (typical fertilizer for a brassica, without a soil test, in sandy soil in 10-10-10; in heavy soil 17-17-17). If you've planted brassicas for 2 years, you may want to switch to a legume like Soybeans or Austrian Winter Peas (annuals) or if you just want to give the soil a chance to replenish itself over the next 2-3 years, plant a clover; also, a legume. The legumes create nitrogen and are a great crop rotation choice after growing brassicas. Other good fall plantings are Winter Rye and Winter Wheat (Annuals).
