

Loose Implement Trailer Rips Car; Driver Hurt

John F. Doyle, 38, of Cincinnati, was injured shortly before noon yesterday when a large runaway implement trailer struck his automobile, four and one-half miles southwest of Muncie.

He was removed to the hospital here suffering from a broken ankle. His condition was reported as "fair" late last night at Ball Hospital.

Doyle was en route to the northeast part of the state when, as he approached a dump truck headed southwest and driven by Claude Young, 33, of 1318 West Thirteenth street, Muncie, a large flat steel

trailer broke loose from the truck and swerved across the highway and sideswiped the Doyle car, tearing out one side of the automobile.

State Trooper Albert Merkle, who was in Daleville at the time, investigated the collision. Trooper Robert P. Adams and Sheriff W. Pete Anthony were in the vicinity of Albany when they heard the report of the accident and also went to the scene.
