Mayor Stirton called the meeting to order and the opening prayer was led by John Calhoon. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Hearing for Razo Property @ 105 East 8th Street

Motion by Commissioner Edwards to authorize the city attorney to prepare a Resolution for presentment on October 7th for the Commission directing that the property at 105 East 8th be removed or repaired on or before October 27th, or the city will be authorized to rehabilitate the property, including by repair or demolition. Seconded by Commissioner Bacon. All aye.

Razo, who was present, was not able to show cause why the building should not be condemned.

Kevin Hill recommended that the city administrator proceed with the asbestos testing and contacting a contractor for demolition.
