FORMAT:	Two Best Balls of Four – all scores must be entered through USGA TM program. Holiday Season Golf Attire is encouraged. Please bring an unwrapped toy for our Toys for Tots Drive. Lunch will immediately follow play upstairs in the large dining room.
AWARDS:	Awards will be given to 1/3 of the field in gross and net. Ties will be broken by card-off according to USGA guidelines and procedures.
ENTRY FEE:	\$460 (\$115 per person). ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO 128 PEOPLE . Entry fee includes green fees, cart and range balls and a luncheon in dining room. NO REFUND AFTER CLOSING DATE. See SDCWGA Website for complete information on Field Days and the refund policy.
ENTRY FORM:	You may enter on our web site at <u>http://www.sdcwga.net</u> . No mailed entries will be accepted. You must enter with 4 people.
PLAYER SUBS:	In the event you need to substitute a player (illness or family emergency) for any team event you must notify the Director in Charge of the competition at least 72 hours before the start of play. Failure to do so may result in the substitute player's score not being allowed in the competition. Late substitutions may be accepted upon committee Review.
