

## Noisy play

### WHAT YOU NEED

Any noise making toy or use household items, such as saucepans, plastic plates, cardboard boxes and spoons to bang on them.

### HOW TO PLAY

This game will only work with children who like a lot of noise.

You hold the noisemaker. Make lots of noise and then stop.

Wait for the child to make eye contact before you make the sound again. Once the child is looking at you, you can start making the noise. If they stop looking at you, stop the noise. Do it all over again.

### PLAY IT A DIFFERENT WAY

Try this with Peek-a-boo or tickling games.

Children love these games and they can be played anywhere, for example hiding behind furniture etc. Make sure the child looks at you, before you start to hide for peek-a-boo or before you start to tickle them gently.
