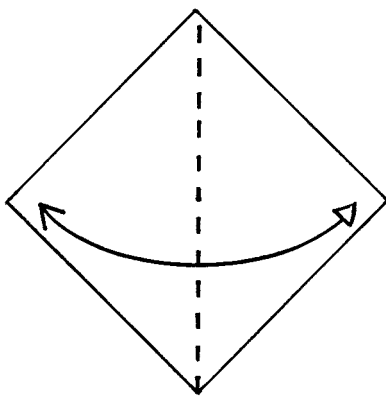


# Tree

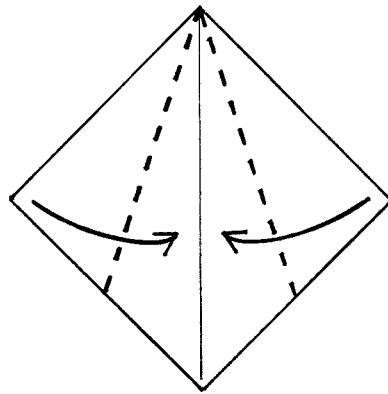

## Simple

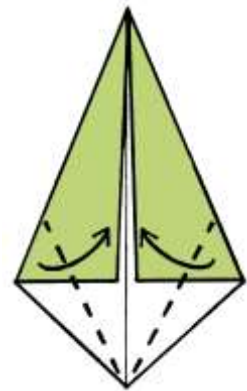
You can include Tree in the background of scenes or dioramas that you make using origami models. Fold the model from either a 6-inch square of green origami paper or an 8½-inch square of green bond paper. (When creating landscapes, choose squares in different sizes or in a variety of shades of green to add interest.)



**1** Start with the white side of the paper facing up. Fold the right corner to the left corner then open the fold.



**2** Fold the upper right edge to the center crease. Fold the upper left edge to the center crease.

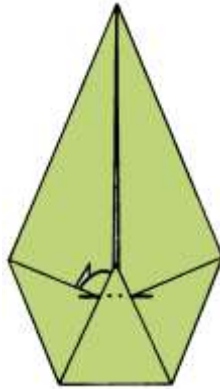


**3** Fold the right bottom edge to the center crease. Fold the left bottom edge to the center crease.

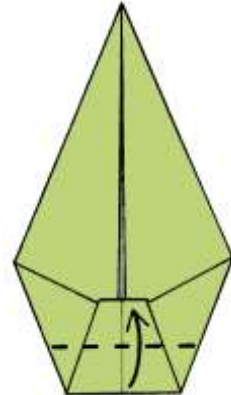

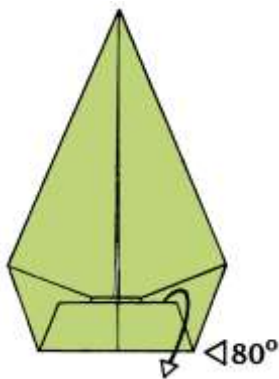
**4** Fold the bottom corner up to the approximate center point of the model.



**5** Tuck the upper portion of the flap behind the folded edges, making a mountain fold.



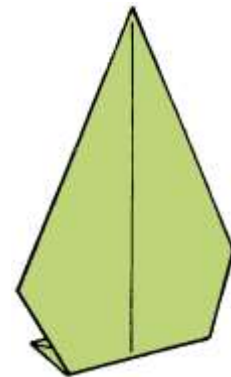
**6** Fold the bottom edge up to the fold that you just made.



**7** Unfold the flap so that it forms an angle with the rest of the model that is a little less than a right angle. Stand the model on a table.



**8** Turn the model around so that it is in the position shown in the next step.



**9** You can make a forest by folding a number of trees.
