

TRAINING CURRICULUM

TAILWHEEL ENDORSEMENT

GROUND: Airplane Flying Handbook Chapter 13 (home reading); ground on tailwheel ops and J-3 Cub specs (1 hr)

STAGE ONE: Preflight inspection; handpropping; ground and taxi ops; 4 fundamentals; airspeed transitions; trim; coordination and dutch rolls (2 hrs)

STAGE TWO: Slow flight; stalls power off and on; steep turns; ground reference maneuvers; simulated engine outs; power off accuracy approaches and landings (2 hrs)

STAGE THREE: Cruise ops; navigation systems; unfamiliar airport ops; emergency descents (2 hrs)

STAGE FOUR: Takeoffs and landings, 3 point and wheel; go arounds; system and equipment malfunctions (2 hrs)

STAGE FOUR ENDS WITH TAILWHEEL ENDORSEMENT!!!

(9 hour curriculum, but times will vary given pilot proficiency, and could be less)
