This privacy policy sets out how Y Fron Development Group uses and protects any personal information you provide when using the website www.fron.org.uk, contacting the Group or corresponding with the Group

THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We may collect the following information:

- Name
- Address, telephone numbers, e-mail address
- Age, date of birth
- Place of work
- Job title/description

WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION WE GATHER

We use your personal details to provide information related to the activities of Y Fron Development Group, and in particular for the following reasons:

- To inform you of activities, meetings and upcoming events
- To send surveys and questionnaires
- To respond to questions or requests
- To maintain a register of members

SECURITY

We are committed to ensuring your personal information is secure:

- In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have in place suitable physical and electronic procedures to safeguard any personal information we hold.
- Your personal details will not be released to a third party for purposes not directly related to the activities of the Group without your express permission
- Links on the Group's website to other websites are not covered by this policy

RETENTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We will only retain your personal information as long as it is necessary and only if:

- You have given your consent to its retention
- It is pertinent to the activities of the Group
- You have not subsequently asked for it to be erased

CONTROLLING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

You can choose to restrict collection or use of your personal information:

- The Group maintains a register of members names which is available for public viewing. There are no contact details included in the membership list. You may have your name removed from the public membership list by writing to the Group or e-mailing the Group at fron.group@yahoo.co.uk
- When you use the 'contact us' page on the website you will need to indicate whether or not the Group may retain any personal details you have entered
- You can request a copy of the personal details we hold about you
- You can have any of your personal details corrected or changed
- You can request erasure of your personal details
