It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Marvin E. Ceynar at the Beehive Care home in Maple Grove, MN. A memorial service will be held August 18, 2025 with visitation at 10:30 and service at 11:00 A.M. at Brunswick United Methodist Church, 6122 North 42nd Ave., Crystal, MN. A light luncheon to follow.

Marvin E. Ceynar was born September 30, 1934 to Emil and Mary Ceynar on a farm near Swisher, IA. He attended Amana schools graduating in 1952. He obtained an MA degree in religion at the U. of Iowa in 19554. In 1957 he entered Garret Seminary in Evanston, IL, where he obtained a Master of Divinity degree, while serving as pastor of a mission Methodist church in Chicago.

Marvin returned to Iowa in 1962 and served as pastor of 3 churches while attending the U. of Iowa. His thesis was a study of Martin Luther King Jr. the first professional writing on King in the U.S. After graduating with an MA in Speech communication he moved to Sycamore, IL to serve as pastor of a United Church of Christ congregation and teach Speech at Northern IL. University. He had a program on NPR on Lincoln.

Back in Iowa he served at 6 more Methodist churches, wrote many magazine articles and 2 books. He was listed twice in Who’s who in America. In retirement he received a humanitarian award.

Marvin is survived by his wife Barbara, daughter Sue (Ismail), son John (Alicia), sister Dolores Meyer, five grandchildren and one great-grand-child.
