<u>First Lesson</u> Genesis 1:26-28 <u>26</u> Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."<u>27</u> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.<u>28</u> And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

<u>Second Lesson</u> Colossians 1:15-20 <u>15</u> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. <u>16</u> For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. <u>17</u> And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. <u>18</u> And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. <u>19</u> For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, <u>20</u> and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.
