In 2021, BCAH staff and its Board of Directors continued to rework the organization after the unfortunate passing of its longtime President/Treasurer, Sherill Bunetta. Sherill was a tireless volunteer who gave as much as 25-30 per week to the organization. BCAH's new President, Chippy Cianci, and valued board members carried the torch that Sherill passed to them, while also recognizing that no one could fill her shoes. Therefore, the Board became a policy and oversight board to serve the organization as best as they could.

Bcah and its programs continued to pivot the manner in which events and experiences were presented due to the ongoing effects of the pandemic on in-person offerings. While some programs continued to be creative in how they interacted in-person, some chose to continue their virtual offerings since indoor events were difficult to manage.

Despite the adversity, our programs persevered and appreciated that both BCAH programs and BCAH itself proved to be resilient. In 2021, BCAH celebrated 48 years of providing entertaining and educational programs to the Broomfield community. Your support enabled us to provide the resources we need to bring diverse opportunities to Broomfield.

The support for arts, culture, and creative programming in our community is an integral part of how we can achieve the mission of BCAH. BCAH has been privileged to present engaging programs and event and also provide administrative support to arts and cultural organizations desiring to share their talents with the residents of Broomfield and surrounding areas.



### 2021 BCAH Programs

#### ASTER Women's Chamber Choir Dr. Christina Lynn-Craig

The meaning of the name "ASTER" comes from *The Meaning of Flowers* in which Gretchen Scoble wrote, "Asters speak of the tiny beginnings from which all great things proceed." ASTER is a small (20-voice) women's ensemble in Broomfield.

#### Broomfield Community Players Russ & Jo Ramsey

The year 2016 was the premiere of BCAH's Broomfield Community Players (BCP), a theatrical group for those 16 years and older. Community input indicated a desire for an adult theatrical group. BCP has produced The Importance of Being Earnest, Plaza Suite, and Death Trap.

# Broomfield Days Poster Contest—BCAH program BCAH Staff

The 3rd Saturday of September draws in Broomfield and surrounding communities to Midway Park to celebrate all that Broomfield has to offer, including the Broomfield Days Poster Contest Winning entry. BCAH manages the contest and provides a youth craft at its booth. It also provides information on BCAH member groups, programs and the historical Brunner Farmhouse.

#### Broomfield Film Project Heather Doran

BFP, a new program of Broomfield Council on the Arts and Humanities, is coordinated by Heather Doran, who began her film career creating props for the Disney movie 10 Things I Hate About You before becoming a Location Scout and Manager on films including Life or Something Like It starring Angelina Jolie and Solaris starring George Clooney. Most recently she was a Location Scout on Amateur, a basketball story filmed here in Colorado and released in April on Netflix. Heather is excited to bring film viewing events to the Broomfield community and to offer unique opportunities for residents and non-residents alike to learn about filmmakers and the film-making process.

#### Broomfield Spellbinders Kay Landers & Wynn Montgomery

The mission of Spellbinders is to nurture character, community, and the spirit of humanity through the art of oral storytelling. The Broomfield Spellbinders are trained volunteer storytellers whose main purpose is to tell stories to elementary school students in order to strengthen their creative thinking skills and listening and writing skills and foster intergenerational relationships with the mostly senior volunteers.

# Community Enrichment Program BCAH Staff

This program provides a variety of events each year, including the Annual Student Art Show, Halloween Event, and other children and family events. It also serves as an incubator program for potentially new programs that first begin as single events or series.

#### Science+Art Experiences BCAH Staff

At the foundation of art and science is creativity. Creativity is what sparks the intellect to imagine new possibilities, motivates the spirit to pursue one's dreams, and inspires someone to explore their world or invent something new, whether it's a piece of artwork or space technology for a mission to Mars. To recognize creative experiences as "essential," BCAH created the Science+Art Experiences program to bring artistic and science-based events for education and community enrichment.

# Summer Sundays/Summer Saturday Drive-thru's BCAH Staff

Summer Sunday Fests are free community festivals held each year in June, July, and August which have been held for decades. Enjoy this Broomfield tradition! Each event features a booth portion with interactive stations from 4-6 p.m., followed by a live concert from 6-8 p.m.

These events bring interactive and enriching experiences to the community and provide artists and groups with the opportunity to connect with the public. Depending on the unpredictable Colorado Summer weather, attendance numbers range from 175-700. Due to COVID-19, the Sunday festivals were transformed into the Summer Saturday Drive-thru events in 2020. These events were held in various locations including in front of the Broomfield Library and at the FlatIron Mall. The drive -thru experiences featured art displays, cultural artifact displays, live music, performances, and a classic car show.

#### The Broomshticks Dayna Scott & Mary Wilkie

The Broomshticks Improv Group is dedicated to sharing all the silliness, whimsy, and belly-laughing possible with Broomfield and surrounding communities! Formed in 2016 as an outgrowth of Broomfield Community Players, The Broomshticks has grown over the past two years and is proud to be stepping out as a focused program of BCAH to provide free improvisational acting programs, ticketed events in local venues, and performance opportunities in the greater metro area.

#### Broomfield Civic Chorus Bob Pearson ^ Sue McKnight

In 2015, the Broomfield Civic Chorus successfully presented 3 concerts and were invited to perform at community events such as the Memorial Day Community Picnic, City of Broomfield's July 4th Celebration, Thanksgiving Ecumenical Service, Veteran's Day program, and City of Broomfield's Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony. Founded by Barbara Schipper in 1989, the Broomfield Civic Chorus (BCC) is a community choir open to all who love to sing. They have consistently provided service to the community, joy to their audiences, and satisfaction in a job well done. The Broomfield Civic Chorus is a county institution beloved by residents, city officials and the media. The BCC is proud to provide their concerts to the Broomfield Community.

#### Chadash Dance Kelly & Regan Archer

Chadash Contemporary Dance Movement is a contemporary dance company that brings creative and thought-provoking performances by local and national dancers to the Broomfield Auditorium. The Hebrew verb Chadash comes from a primitive root word that means to be new; to rebuild, renew, repair and restore. Chadash launched in 2016 and is a professional company, based in the Denver area, passionate about its mission. We tell stories through well-crafted dance and other media, to cultivate renewal, reparation and restoration in a broken world. We want to honestly acknowledge the world as it is, and as hope-bearers, through the aesthetic of dance, engage in the conversation of what it can be. Through transcendent, human choreography and art that cuts to the heart, is thought provoking and soul-stirring, we "stand in the ashes of the barn burned down, and point to the moon, one foot in suffering, one foot in hope."

#### Annual Student Art Show—BCAH Collaboration with City of Broomfield Parks and Rec Department

Running for more than 40 years, this event showcases the artwork of local students. Art teachers in elementary through high schools within Broomfield County are asked to participate in the show held in the Lakeshore Room of the Broomfield Community Center every March. Students have the opportunity to experience being part of an art show and celebrated during an evening reception with piano music provided by student pianists who placed in the Annual Piano Festival.

#### Broomfield Piano Festival—BMTA Cheryl Reeder

BCAH supported the 44th Annual Piano Festival. The Broomfield Music Teachers' Association (BMTA) was founded more than three decades ago and organized the beloved Broomfield Piano Festival to offer young piano students an opportunity to perform and be evaluated by professional judges. The community is encouraged to attend the afternoon concert performed by the finalists. Winners of each division are announced at the end of the age appropriate division concert. Students compete in four divisions: Division 1 (5th and 6th graders), Division 2 (7th and 8th graders), Division 3 (9th and 10th graders), and Division 4 (11th and 12th graders).
