EMBARK partners with many community organizations to provide a wide range of transportation programs to meet our residents' diverse needs. Through these programs, qualified customers can maintain mobility and independence by arranging their own transportation to access community services.

All services require a brief application process. Applications based on a disabling condition may require verification of the applicant's functional disability by a physician or other certified health care professional.

Partnerships

EMBARK also partners with a variety of organizations and groups to develop human service transportation programs to make a positive impact in the community. These programs are referral- and need-based and not open to the public.

Climb Ride - Child Welfare

The Climb Ride Program is the first of its kind mobility service designed to imbed mobility coordination into the case management system to improve social service outcomes. EMBARK provides transportation coordination, travel training, and case management support to program participants using The Science of Hope to foster goal setting and pathways to long-term success. The Climb Ride model is being used to serve the following populations:

- Oklahoma County Child Welfare -Department of Human Services
- Transition Age Youth in Oklahoma County - Partnering with Pivot: A Turning Point for Youth

ReMerge and HopeHouse OKC

EMBARK Mobility Services partners with ReMerge of Oklahoma County and HopeHouse OKC to provide transportation services to single mothers participating in pre-trial diversion programs.

Palomar

In partnership with Palomar, Oklahoma City's Family Justice Center, this program provides transportation services for victims of domestic violence, elder abuse, and human trafficking.





Senior Transportation Services 405-297-2583

Through a partnership with the Areawide Aging Agency, EMBARK offers a range of transportation options to individuals age 60+ who live within our service area. Senior transportation services are free to participants, although donations are accepted. All senior transportation services require arrangements to be made in advance of the date transportation is needed. Lift-equipped vehicles operate on weekdays and weekends and are available based on availability.

Congregate Meal Shuttle

This service is a round-trip, door-to-door transportation from the participant's residence or senior citizen center to the nearest senior nutrition site, allowing for a meal and socialization on weekdays through a partnership with the Oklahoma County Senior Nutrition Project.

Daily Living Centers

This program provides round-trip, door-to-door transportation to the Daily Living Center, an adult day center, providing nutrition, nurse monitoring, therapeutic programs, and physical/occupational therapy. Call the Daily Living Centers directly at 405-792-2401.

Interim Urgent Need Service

This service is a round-trip, door-to-door service for essential weekday trips taken 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. Participants must be unable to secure transportation from any other source.

Non-Emergency Medical

This service is round-trip, door-to-door transportation from participant's residence to non-emergency medical appointments. Transportation must be scheduled at least three days prior to the appointment.

OCPD Crime Victims Transportation

This program provides seniors who are victims of a crime no-cost, round-trip, door-to-door transportation services to manage their case to resolution. Seniors must have a referral from an Oklahoma City Police Department staff member.

STEP Shopping Shuttle

Round-trip, door-to-door transportation to designated area grocery stores. Participants are picked up at their residence, senior citizen center, or a senior nutrition meal site, then dropped off to shop for one hour, and returned home.

EMBARK Well

Funded by EMBARK and the City of OKC this service provides no-cost, round-trip transportation to residents of Oklahoma City aged 60 or older to any MAPS3 Senior Health and Wellness Center, all Y.M.C.A. locations, and all OKC Parks locations.

Transportation must be scheduled to the nearest wellness center to the participant's address and at least one day in advance.

Income and Age-Based Transportation Services

405-235-RIDE (7433)

All transportation programs require arrangements to be made in advance of the date transportation is needed.

Helpline Service

This service is a round-trip, door-to-door, single-use emergency service for medical services or other urgently needed transportation for homeless or low-income individuals. The service is coordinated through multiple social service agencies and is underwritten by EMBARK and the City of Oklahoma City. For an agency referral, call 405-297-2372.

Reduced Fare

Bus, streetcar, and river fares and passes are halfprice for persons 65+, students ages 7 to 17, and individuals with a valid medical certification of disability.

Regional Food Bank

This service is a no-cost, no-contact delivery of monthly food boxes from the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma. To learn if you qualify for food distribution services and to schedule your delivery, contact the Food Bank directly at 405-972-1111.

Share-A-Fare Program

This service is round-trip, door-to-door transportation to destinations within and outside of the EMBARK service area. This program offers participants 52 trip subsidies of up to \$4 toward the cost of each trip. Share-A-Fare requires an application and approval prior to use.

Social Service Bus Passes

Social service agencies qualify individuals needing urgent transportation for a nocost, one-day bus pass on EMBARK's fixed-route bus service. This service is coordinated through multiple social service agencies and is underwritten by EMBARK and the City of Oklahoma City. For an agency referral, call 405-297-2372.

EMBARK Plus

405-235-RIDE (7433)

Shared-ride, public transportation to eligible individuals within the Oklahoma City and Norman city limits who are not functionally able to ride our fixed-route bus service due to a disabling condition. Lift-equipped vehicles are available based on availability. For an application call 405-235-RIDE (7433).

EMBARK Plus fares vary:

- **OKC Zone 1:** \$3.50 one way | \$7.00 round-trip
- OKC Zone 2: \$7.00 one way | \$14.00 round-trip
- OKC Zone 3: \$10.50 one way | \$21.00 round-trip.
- Norman fixed-route and paratransit do not currently accept fees.
- EMBARK does not guarantee the availability of service in Zone 2 and Zone 3.

EMBARK Plus requires an advance trip reservation, accepted one to seven days prior to the trip date. In addition, an application and eligibility determination process including physician certification is required prior to using EMBARK Plus.
