



Dear Prospective Family,

Thank you for your interest in our K-5 Home School program starting this Fall on September 8! We understand that selecting the right school for your child is an extremely important decision.

Our Home School program will have small class sizes fostering wonderful interaction between children and teachers. We will be a place where your children will be loved and challenged rather than getting lost in the crowd.

All children are expected to participate in their educational growth both at our studio and at home with their families. They will be challenged to grow both intellectually and spiritually.

Students are engaged every day in a broad number of subject areas. They interact with great books and materials. They are encouraged to love their studies and to find delight in God's creation. Through training in habits of mind and attention, our students are equipped with the tools they need for a lifetime of learning and service.

If these ideas resonate with you, we invite you to contact us for an interview for a seat with our Homeschool Program starting this fall. Below are the specifics that will help you know if we are the right direction to explore for your child's educational growth.

All students must interview for a seat for this Fall and ongoing each school year. Not everyone will be selected and may continue to interview each year.

Your Childs interview:

Your interview could consist of one or all the following. Come prepared to sing 1 song of your choice. Be prepared that we may ask you to either mimic or read something to showcase their poise and performance skills. We will talk about your child's dance passion and visions. Your child will be scored on the following: Listening skills, manners, ability to take direction. We welcome beginner, intermediate or advanced children. We welcome everyone who has a passion for Performing Arts, and we know we all need to start somewhere. Interviews will NOT be scary. They will be FUN and HAPPY. This interview will allow us to learn more about your goals, your family, and your child's vision.

It is important to understand what Homeschool is:

We are a piece to your child's education. Our classes will teach out of the Bob Jones Curriculum. It is the responsibility of each family to purchase the required curriculum. The academics will cover Reading, Language Arts, Spelling, Math, Social Studies and Science. We will work academically with your child from **8:30am-11:45am Monday - Thursday**. We will not have school on Fridays; however, it will be your responsibility to continue and further your Childs Homeschool education at home and we recommend you use Fridays to homeschool together as a family. You will need to make sure you find time to finish all activities, keep your child on their educational task and work with our team to make sure they are getting the highest education both at our studio and at home.

After Academics and Performing Arts Study:

From **12:00-1:30pm** your child will work with our studios organized Homeschool Performing Arts curriculum. The curriculum could have slight changes come the fall; however, it will look something like this:

Mondays: Piano, Music Theory, Percussion/Rhythm

Tuesdays: Ballet/Jazz Dance, Acting (your child may elect for independent Music study in place of Ballet/Jazz Dance)

Wednesday: Tap Dance, Voice, Show Choir (your child may elect for independent music study in place of Tap Dance)

Thursday: Hip-Hop Dance, Show Choir, Acting (your child may elect for independent music study in place of Hip-Hop Dance)

Tuition will be as follows:

Homeschool Full Program Monday-Thursday 8:30am-1:30pm \$6800 a year.

We offer payment programs.

You do have the option to audition for...

Home School Performing Arts program from 12-1:30 Monday-Thursday.

The tuition will be \$3040 a year. We offer payment programs. There is a \$115 nonrefundable yearly registration fee per student however we are waiving this fee for the launch of our 2020-2021 school year.

School Attire: 2 School shirts provided per student and will be worn Monday-Thursday with comfortable shorts or leggings. You may purchase extra school shirts.

Dance attire: If you are taking dance, you will be required to purchase and wear dance attire for dance classes. Tan tights, black leotard, black jazz shorts, beige jazz shoes, pink ballet slippers for girls and black for boys, black tap shoes and girls must have hair pulled back in a bun.

Graduation: We are committed to hosting an extra special end of the year graduation for all the kids K-5. The kids will perform an end of the year graduation production. Our Homeschool staff will call up each grade and child for a personalized moment. We will have a special ceremony for the 5th grade kids graduating.
