

2019-20 Annual Youth Singles / Doubles Tournament Rules

- 1. Administration: The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress will administer this tournament.
- 2. **Cost: SINGLES** \$25.00 per bowler. **DOUBLES** \$50.00 per team (\$25.00 per person). Scratch SMART Prize Fund Payout (optional) is \$5.00 per bowler. Scratch SMART money will be based on number of entries per division.
 - **a.** Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. **Walk-in entries will close 30 minutes** prior to start of next shift. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
 - b. Payment must accompany entry form. Spots will not be held without full payment.
 - c. All bowlers on a team must pay scratch to qualify for the optional Scratch SMART Prize Fund Payout.
- 3. Eligibility: This tournament is open to all youth bowlers who hold a current USBC Youth membership.
- 4. **All Events:** The \$5.00 All Events fee must be paid with your **FIRST** City Tournament entry. All Events scores are calculated using the total of the first series bowled in the City Doubles, Singles and Team. Scholarships will be awarded to the champion in each division. The number of entries, in each division, will determine the amount of the scholarship.
- 5. **Doubles:** Two (2) members per team. They may be comprised of all boy, all girl or mixed (boy and girl).
- Participation: Bowlers may bowl more than one time, but teammates must be changed.
- 7. Handicap: Singles Handicap will be 90% of 215. Doubles Handicap will be 90% of 430 (all divisions).
- 8. **Averages**: Average used will be the <u>highest</u> average from the <u>2018-2019 bowl.com</u> for <u>12</u> games. If a bowler does not have an existing 2018-2019 average listed on bowl.com, he/she will enter the tournament as a scratch 215, unless the bowler is able to provide a current standing sheet from a <u>2019-2020 USBC</u> sanctioned youth league with an average comprised of at least <u>9</u> games.
- 9. **Re-rates:** If the league was a <u>sport and/or challenger condition</u> league, the average will be adjusted according to the rule#201c (rate will be adjusted to the rate published in the current USBC rate chart).

10. Format for the Tournament:


- a. This handicap tournament will be conducted in four age divisions: Bantam, Prep, Junior and Major.
- b. There will be three categories for each division: Boy, Girl and Mixed (boy and girl).
 - i. The Bantam division will not have categories and will all be competing in one division.
 - ii. The oldest team member determines the division in which you will bowl.
- c. There is an OPTIONAL scratch SMART prize fund payout for all divisions and categories. Both bowlers for Doubles must enter to qualify.
- d. All divisions will bowl three (3) games.
- e. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
- f. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within one half hour of the completion of the shift bowled in which the error occurred.
- g. Tardy Bowlers: Teams and/or bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
- h. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be presented.
- 11. **Entry Forms**: Entry form must be **COMPLETELY FILLED OUT & LEGIBLE**. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Incorrect or illegible information on entry form can lead to disqualification.
- 12. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
- 13. **AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS**: GDUSBC will present awards based on <u>one for every seven</u> entries in each age division up to a maximum of ten awards. Awards for this <u>handicap tournament</u> will be presented at the annual awards banquet. Scholarships for this handicap tournament will be based on one out of every ten in each division. The optional scratch SMART prize fund payouts will be based on one out of every ten in each division.
- 14. **Dress Code:** The tournament dress code will be in accordance to USBC Rule 301b. Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
- 15. **Conduct:** Tournament Officials may warn or disqualify bowlers for unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct. There will be a zero tolerance policy for foul language, rude gestures, or abuse of bowling center equipment. Tournament Officials and/or Bowling Center Management may remove any coach or spectator for disruptive conduct and if necessary, suspend them from attending future tournaments.
- 16. All City: All city is an additional recognition program that is open to Greater Dayton USBC youth bowlers only.
