## SPORTS REMINDER

**Students are reminded that they need the following for PE lessons this term.**

If students are taking part in rugby or football lessons they will require a school rugby shirt, black shorts, black football socks and studded footwear. Please note that shin pads for football are compulsory and a gum shield is also highly recommended for rugby.

If students have a note from parents/guardians excusing them from PE they should still bring their PE kit (except in cases of major long term injury) as they are still expected to take part in the lessons, either by working in groups and helping coach/referee or assisting the teacher and students.

As the weather changes going into Autumn please remember that rugby shirts provide warmth and strength whilst the students play outdoor sports. Studded footwear is required for the outdoor grass fields, football boots with plastic or metal studs or astro turf trainers also work well.
