Stressed Trees? Please Water them!

California's drought is taking a toll on plants and trees.

If trees in your yard or street trees in front of your house are showing signs of stress from lack of water (dry curling leaves, losing leaves, etc.) please water them!

Yes, it is ok to water the trees in this drought.

When mulching trees, wood chips are best. Avoid rubber, rocks, decomposed granite, weed cloth, artificial turf, plastic as these can trap heat in the soil and cause damage to tree roots.
