

Ordinance. No. 568

An ordinance in relation to billiard halls in the city of Garnett, Kansas, and being supplemental to ordinance No. 201 on the same subject and to repeal Ordinance No. 544.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and board of commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Sec. 1. That any person or persons keeping or maintaining in the city of Garnett, Kansas, as a source of profit and pay, any billiard table or tables, or pool table or tables, shall pay to said city a license tax of \$ 200<sup>00</sup> per annum ~~for the first table:~~ \$

~~for the second table, and \$~~ \_\_\_\_\_ ~~for each additional table~~  
~~so kept or maintained,~~ and shall keep or maintain such tables in a room or hall, said room or hall to front on and be adjacent to some public street in said city, and have in front thereof not less than two windows of clear glass, or said room or hall shall have a clear glass front, said windows or glass front to be unobscured by screens or otherwise, and also have in front thereof at least one door, and all doors and doorways in said room or hall to be unobscured by screens or otherwise, said room or hall to be on the grade floor and so arranged that a clear view can be had to all parts thereof from the sidewalk in front thereof ~~to all parts~~

~~of said room or hall.~~ Said license tax shall be due and payable on the <sup>taking effect of this ordinance and on the</sup> first day of July and January of each year after the passage of this ordinance.

Sec. 2. This ordinance to be supplemental to and in lieu of original section one of said ordinance No. 201. and all references made <sup>to said sec. 1.</sup> in ~~section~~ said ordinance No. 201 shall refer to Sec. 1. of this ordinance.

Sec. 3. Ordinance No. 544 ~~being ordinance~~ in relation to billiard tables and pool tables and amending Sec. 1. of ordinance No. 201 and repealing the same, <sup>and ordinance No 547</sup> ~~are~~ hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force according to law, from its final passage, and its publication.
