First Lesson **Lamentations 3:19-27** [19](#) Remember my affliction and my wanderings, the wormwood and the gall![20](#) My soul continually remembers it and is bowed down within me.[21](#) But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope:[22](#) The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end;[23](#) they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.[24](#) “The Lord is my portion,” says my soul, “therefore I will hope in him.”[25](#) The Lord is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him.[26](#) It is good that one should wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord.[27](#) It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.

Second Lesson **1 Corinthians 9:19-23** [19](#) For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.[20](#) To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law (though not being myself under the law) that I might win those under the law.[21](#) To those outside the law I became as one outside the law (not being outside the law of God but under the law of Christ) that I might win those outside the law.[22](#) To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some.[23](#) I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings.

Gospel **John 3:27-36** [27](#) John answered, “A person cannot receive even one thing unless it is given him from heaven.[28](#) You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, ‘I am not the Christ, but I have been sent before him.’”[29](#) The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete.[30](#) He must increase, but I must decrease.”[31](#) He who comes from above is above all. He who is of the earth belongs to the earth and speaks in an earthly way. He who comes from heaven is above all.[32](#) He bears witness to what he has seen and heard, yet no one receives his testimony.[33](#) Whoever receives his testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true.[34](#) For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for he gives the Spirit without measure.[35](#) The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand.[36](#) Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

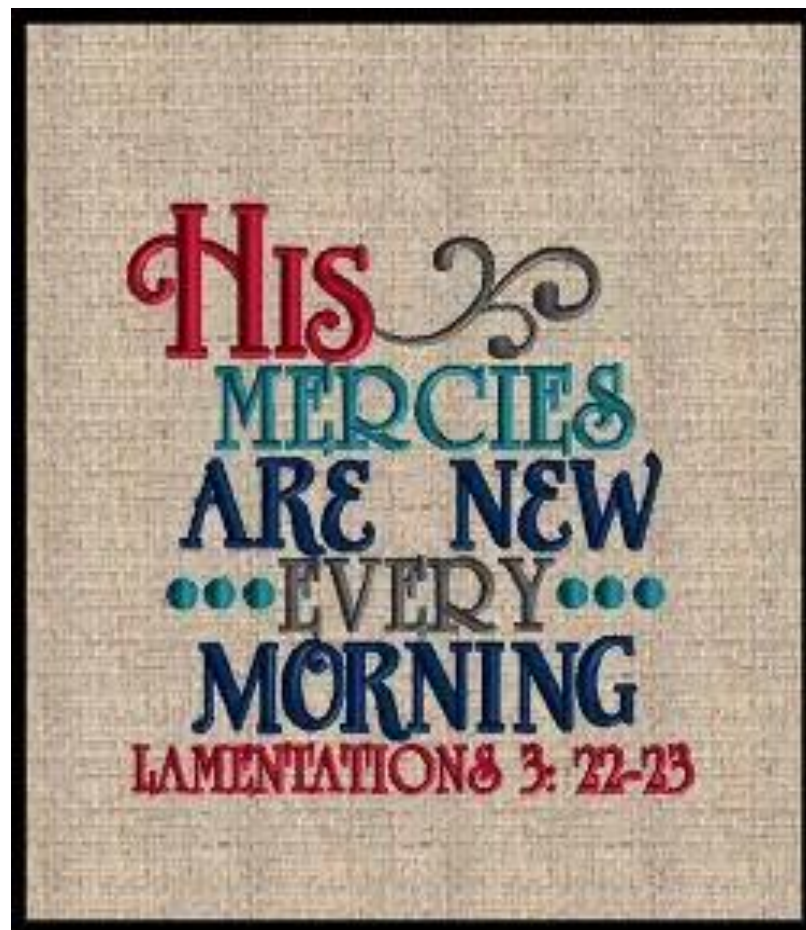
