The 1611 King James Bible was translated from the “Textus Receptus” (Received Text). These are the manuscripts all the Early Christians recognized as the Inerrant, Infallible, Word of God. And these are the scriptures which came from Antioch where the disciples were first called Christians (Acts 11:26). All the translators came to an untimely end at the hands of God's Antichrist enemies.

All the other Bible translations are actually Roman Catholic which came from Alexandria, Egypt that are the Vaticanus and Siniaticus manuscripts. In spite of the fact that the Vaticanus and Siniaticus disagree with each other over 3,000 times and disagree with the Texus Receptus 5,337 times just in the Gospels alone. Also 998 other manuscripts disagree with them also. Whenever Satan's counterfeit manuscripts disagreed with God's Texus Receptus, the translators choose to use Satan's instead. Many Bible Publishers have even taken the Letter of Dedication out of the front of all King James Bibles today. KJV: "How art thou fallen from heaven, **O Lucifer, son of the morning!**" *Isaiah 14:12*

RSV: "How you are fallen from heaven, **O Day Star, son of Dawn** (Calling Satan the Day Star, which is Jesus Christ, is a **Hellish Blasphemy!**)" *Isaiah 14:12*

KJV: We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and **the day Star (Jesus Christ)** arise in your hearts." *2Peter 1:19* "I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. **I AM** the root and the offspring of David, and the bright

and **morning star.**" *Rev 22:16* "And I (Jesus) will give him (that overcometh) the **morning star.**" *Rev 2:28*

KJV: "And the priest shall set the woman before the Lord, and **uncover the woman's head** (It being a shame for her head to be uncovering)." *Numbers 5:18, see 1 Corinthians 11:5,10*

"For she (Rebekah) had said unto the servant, What man is this that walketh in the field to meet us? And the servant had said, It is my master (Isaac): therefore she **took a veil**, and **covered herself** (The head covering being a sign of subjection and obedience to man. Always worn by women, for hundreds of years in all the churches, now in rebellion)." *Genesis 24:65*

RSV: "And the priest shall set the woman before the Lord, and **unbind the hair** of the woman's head (the head covering is missing)" *Numbers 5:18* (The heresie of hair being a covering was attempted in the early church, and stopped quickly. *1 Corinthians 11:15,16,19*

KJV: "We shall all stand before the judgment seat of **Christ**" "So then every one of us shall give account of himself to **God.**" *Romans 14:10,12*

NAS: "For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of God (not Christ)" "So then each one of us shall give account of himself to God." *Romans 14:10,12*

RSV: "Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God which he obtained (didn't purchase) with the blood of his own Son (not God's blood)." *Acts 20:28*

KJV: “Take heed, therefore, unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of **God**, which he hath purchased with **his own blood**.” *Acts 20:28*

RSV: “Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God which he obtained (didn’t purchase) with the blood of his own Son (not God’s blood).” *Acts 20:28*

KJV: “Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the **Son of God**?” *John 9:35*

NAS: “Jesus heard that they had put him out; and finding him, He said, Do you believe in the Son of Man (not God)?” *John 9:35*

KJV: “But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and **worshipped him**.” *Mark 5:6*

NAS: “And seeing Jesus from a distance, he ran and bowed down (**not worshipped**) before Him.” *Mark 5:6*

KJV: “And they **worshipped** him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy.” *Luke 24:52*

NAS: “And they (**omitted worshipped him**) returned to Jerusalem with great joy.” *Luke 24:52*

KJV: “But thou Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, **from everlasting**.” *Micah 5:2*

RSV: “But you, O Bethlehem, Ephrathah, who are little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose **origin** (God, Christ had no beginning, he always was), is from of old, from ancient days.”
Micah 5:2

KJV: “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and **having salvation**; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.” *Zechariah 9:9*

RSV: “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Lo, your king comes to you; triumphant and victorious (**he comes with no salvation**) is he, humble and riding on an ass, on a colt the foal of an ass.” *Zechariah 9:9*

KJV: “In whom we have redemption **through his blood**, even the forgiveness of sins.” *Colossians 1:14*

NAS Bible: “in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins (**through his blood, is missing**).”
Colossians 1:14. see Hebrews 9:22

KJV: “Forasmuch then as Christ hath **suffered for us** in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind.” *1Peter 4:1*

NAS: “Therefore since Christ has suffered in the flesh (**he didn't suffer for himself**), arm yourselves also with the same purpose.” *1Peter 4:1*

KJV: “**He is not here, but is risen**: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee.” *Luke 24:6*

RSV: “Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee (**He is not here, but is risen, is missing**).”

Luke 24:6

KJV: “Looking for that blessed hope, and **the glorious appearing** of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ.” *Titus 2:13*

NAS: “Looking for the blessed hope and the **appearing of the glory** of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus (**His glory, and not Him in person**).”

Titus 2:13

KJV: “And Jesus answered him saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, **but by every word of God**.” *Luke 4:4*

NAS: “And Jesus answered him, It is written, Man shall not live on bread alone (**but by every word of God is missing**).” *Luke 4:4*

KJV: “Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold **a virgin** shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel** (God with us).” *Isaiah 7:14, Mat 1:23*

RSV: “Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold a **young woman** shall conceive and bear a son and shall call his name Immanuel (any woman can have a son, but only a virgin could have God’s son).” *Isaiah 7:14*

Good News: “Well then, the Lord himself will give you a sign: a **young woman who is pregnant** will have a son and will name him ‘Immanuel’ (not a virgin).” *Isaiah 7:14*

KJV: “Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing **I know not a man** (she was saying she was a virgin)?” *Luke 1:34*

RSV: “And Mary said to the angel, How shall this be, since **I have no husband** (any woman can have a baby without a husband)?” *Luke 1:34*

KJV: “And **Joseph** and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.” *Luke 2:33*

NAS: “And **His father** and mother were amazed at the things which were being said about Him (Joseph was not his father, God was).” *Luke 2:33*

KJV: “As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.” *1Peter 2:2*

RSV: “Like newborn babes, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up to salvation.” *1Peter 2:2* (“**Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us.**” *Titus 3:5* KJV)

KJV: “He that **believeth** on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that **believeth not** the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” *John 3:36*

NAS: “He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who **does not obey** the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him (Changed from believeth not to obey not. “**Believe** on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved.” *Acts 16:31*.” *John 3:36*

KJV: “Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.” *John 6:47*

NAS: “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life (Believes what? not on Jesus).” *John 6:47*

KJV: “He (Manasseh) wrought much wickedness **in the sight of the Lord**, to provoke Him to anger.” *2Kings 21:6*

Living: “So the Lord was very angry, for Manasseh was an evil man, **in God’s opinion** (God has no opinion, God is always right).” *2Kings 21:6*

KJV: “He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken (prophesy about Jesus while on the cross).” *Psalms 34:20*

Living: “God even protects him from accidents (No prophesy, protecting Jesus bones from being broken on the cross).” *Psalms 34:20*

KJV: “And one shall say unto him, **What are these wounds in thine hands?** Then he shall answer, **Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends** (When I was crucified for you). Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the Lord of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep (His Disciples) shall be scattered; and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.” *Zechariah 13:6,7*

Living: “And if someone asks, Then what are these scars on your **chest** and your **back**? he will say, **I got into a brawl at the home of a friend** (They say Jesus was in brawl, The Prince of Peace)! Awake O sword against my Shepherd, the man who is my associate and equal, says the Lord of hosts. Strike

down the Shepherd and the sheep will scatter, but I will come back and comfort and care for the lambs (This **WAS**, the prophesy of his crucifixion for our sin)." *Zechariah 13:6,7*

KJV: "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up (on a cross)." *John 3:14*

Living: "And as Moses in the wilderness lifted up the bronze image of a serpent **on a pole**, even so must I be lifted up **upon a pole (Added a lie, twice)**." *John 3:14*

KJV: "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and **the blood** of Jesus Christ his Son **cleanseth us from all sin**." *1John 1:7*

Good News: The saving blood of Jesus Christ has been removed in: *Matthew 27:4, 24, 25, Acts 5:28, 20:28, Romans 3:25, 5:19, Ephesians 1:7, 2:13, Colossians 1:20, Hebrews 10:19, 1Peter 1:9, Revelation 1:5, 5:9.*

KJV: "But there were **false prophets** also among the people, even as there shall be **false teachers** among you, who privily shall bring in **damnable heresies**, even **denying the Lord** that bought them, and bring upon themselves destruction. And many shall follow their **pernicious ways**; by reason of whom **the way of truth shall be evil spoken of**." *2 Peter 1:2*
