GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON CONSULAR SERVICE APPLICANTS

WHAT TO DO WHILE AT THE CONSULATE



- Applicant will be allowed to enter 15 minutes before their appointment
- A mask is required to enter the facility
- Your temperature will be checked using a non-contact thermometer.
 If your temperature is 100.4F or higher, you will be asked to go home.
- Only applicant is allowed to enter unless accompanying a minor, very elderly, pregnant or disabled
- Please practice social distancing (6 ft apart)
