

The 100 degree are back again which means any hiccup from the HVAC will cause you a bad day. Now is a great time to take some temperature readings of your supply and mixed air to ensure that those outside air dampers that can't be seen, are closed or not leaking "too much". On a hot day outside you will quickly find the areas that aren't working as designed, plus you can sit inside the unit while doing so to keep you cool. That there is what they call a win-win.

Those of us with high rises (classified by COSA as anything above 75' from the highest point to the closest fire curb) have or will be soon visited by the fire department for their annual inspection. This began a couple of years ago after the Wedgewood fire that killed 5. Last year's inspection focused mainly on emergency generator signage, permitting and inspections. This year is fire lanes, FDC's, and sprinkler / alarm inspections. Don't be surprised if you have a knock on the door if your building falls into this classification.

Summer also means family time while the kids are out of school. Every year we plan one big week long trip as a family getaway. Our trip this year was to Colorado, where we got to feel what a high of 87 feels like. A few years back we visited Tucson with a low of 87 which made us appreciate the weather here a little bit more. This was our first trip with our combined 17,000 pound truck and trailer combination and I can honestly say I am not ready for that again. It took us 24 hours for our return trip of which 21 hours was on the road. Got to love road construction and 65 mph limited tires!

Industry Update—Hazardous Materials Permits by Pete Munoz

Hello Guys I want to pass some information I received the other day. I ran into a Fire Inspector with the City of San Antonio. He asked if he could speak to management. We met with the Fire Inspector and he ask if we had a Hazardous Materials permit. In our case we have a Generator and it has diesel fuel which is Hazardous. The Fire Inspector said that this was NOT a new law its been in effect since 1991 but never enforced. So here is what I found out about the permit

There is a one time fee that is billed there is also the permit fee which depends on the size of the Hazardous material. If you have several Hazardous Materials they only bill for one. They also go by which one of the Hazardous Materials you have the most of on your property. In my case the generator is a 150 gallon and the diesel weighs 8lbs per gallon put me at 1200lbs. You will need to get the Hazardous signage as well and place it on the door leading to were you have your Hazardous chemicals.

The Fire Department they will give you 3 months to comply. The permit is by calendar year not from when you get the permit. I have attached the information on the fees I am working on get the application for the HAZMAT permit. We will be updating the web site to include the application for the permit.


