MEMBERSHIP REPORT Audrey KF6MVH reported there has been a good response for the tower fund and she has sent thank you notes for those that have donated. Regarding the nets we aren't getting very many more participants. Why not? Maybe check out reasons and solutions. Jim AC5QI filled in for Carol KK6OLL for Monday nets for a while. While the repeater is down, there is no 220 nor 440. There is a temporary 2 meter set up in the meantime. There was a suggestion for a questionnaire for solutions for more participation. WE are a service club and our primary service has been keeping the repeater available. There are other means of service such as CERTS, monitoring races, and relays. Also, we need to figure out how to get more members to our meetings. We have special events like pizza, picnic, holiday luncheon that are well attended and we include EBARC.

The next CCCC meeting is the **annual picnic on September 9**. Please try to attend and bring a guest or prospective member.


