Losing your cool can increase your risk of heart problems and high blood pressure, as well as cause headaches and stomach problems. In fact, your risk of a heart attack can rise significantly in the two hours



following an angry outburst. The stress your body feels as a result of anger can cause significant, cumulative damage to your immune system. Unchecked anger can lead to anxiety and depression.

And it's even worse for men. Studies indicate that older men's hostility rating more accurately predicts heart disease than cholesterol, alcohol use, cigarette smoking and obesity.

If your prone to losing your cool, there are some simple things you can do to control anger.

- Take a step back and think about why you are angry. Sometimes the root of the problem is something small and manageable.
- Instead of screaming and yelling, express yourself in a different way.

You can be assertive without screaming and foaming at the mouth.

- Listen. Better communication skills can go a long way in solving a problem. Making others uncomfortable with your behavior is causing problems you will have to deal with later.
- Have a sense of humor about the whole thing. Again, everybody gets angry. You are not breaking new ground by getting upset about things.

Most importantly, let go of your anger once you have expressed it. Life is short. Find a relaxation technique that works for you and use it. Your heart will thank you for it. As will those around you.
