not seen and that one would

not dare to imagine.

Through this wordless witness these Christians stir up irresistible questions in the hearts of those who see how they live: Why are they like this? Why do they live this way? What or who is it that inspires them? Why are they in our midst? Such a witness is already a silent proclamation of the Good News and a very powerful and effective one."

# Holy Spirit Prayer



#### WHAT IS CHRISTIANS ENCOUNTER CHRIST?

Christians Encounter Christ (CEC) is a lay Catholic retreat experience within the Archdiocese of Omaha. Christians Encounter Christ believes that Christianity can penetrate all areas of the secular world, living, growing and transferring Christ's values to society. CEC is an active two and half day "weekend" experience, beginning on Friday evening and ending on Sunday night. It is a combined effort of laity and clergy toward evangelization of the world, in which we live, by strengthened spirituality, lived and shared in everyday situations.

### WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CHRISTIANS ENCOUNTER CHRIST?

"Go then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples;" (Matt 28-19) Saint John Paul II asked us to evangelize. A goal of CEC is to encourage Christian leaders who are willing to live and share their values of being Christian. Through ongoing spiritual growth, these leaders strive to instill the spirit of Christ in all situations in which they live and are actively involved.

### WHAT HAPPENS ON THE WEEKEND?

On the weekend you will join others in song, prayer and discussion. The discussion is centered on eleven talks given by laity and clergy which help you to know, to love and to serve God. The talks present the theme of God's grace in you, how this grace comes more alive in a Christian community, and how to share this grace with others. There is also daily celebration of Mass. This is not a quiet retreat experience, but a lively, joyous Spirit-filled opportunity for you to allow Jesus to work in your life, see and experience Him in the lives around you, and learn practices and methods of perseverance to keep Him in your life and bring Him to others.

## WHAT HAPPENS AFTER A WEEKEND?

After a CEC weekend, you may have a greater awareness of God in your daily life and have a stronger desire to get involved in serving God where you are – with your spouse, family, friends, church or work life.

You will be invited to join a CEC prayer group who meet on a regular basis to reflect, pray and encourage each other in their faith. Avanti is a larger gathering of the CEC community. At an Avanti, the community spirit of the weekend is continued through group sharing, witness, shared prayer and fellowship.

### WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW IN ORDER TO MAKE A WEEKEND?

\* The CEC weekends are held at various locations around the greater Omaha area. The cost of the weekend is \$150 – for lodging, meals & materials. Weekend dates are on the front of this brochure.

\* CEC is a Catholic weekend experience open to persons of all faiths, 24 yrs. of age or older. The only requirement is that you are a Christian who wishes to strengthen your spiritual life.

\* The weekend is open to married, single, divorced and widowed individuals. For married couples ... in an effort to support the marriage sacrament, <u>both</u> spouses are encouraged to be registered by the sponsor at the *same* time so as to attend the same set of weekends. If this is NOT possible, attendance by the other spouse is suggested within 1 yr. of the other.
