Driveway-204 South Trailwood

Public Works Director, Jason Harris stated that Roger Hart located at 204 South Trailwood had some sewer issues and contacted Park Hills. This old clay sewer main runs from Trailwood up between the two houses. Mr. Hart poured a massive concrete driveway over the right of way and this sewer main. Mr. Hart stated he talked to our Building Inspector, Bryan Cato and asked him if he needed a driveway permit and Mr. Cato told him no. Allan from Park Hills contacted Mr. Harris stating they could replace the sewer main but could not do the concrete and wanted to know if Desloge could do the concrete. Mr. Harris stated if we did, the concrete would cost roughly fifteen hundred dollars in materials and concrete. Mr. Harris asked the board if they want to pay for the repair of the concrete. Alderman Gremminger made the motion to do nothing and not get involved and Alderman Hodge seconded the motion. 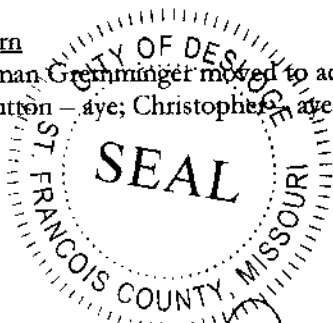
