Exhibition Dates: January 15 through May 10, 2020. (two floors: estimated capacity 75 – 80 artworks)  
Gallery Hours: Wednesday through Saturday, 10am to 4pm and Sunday, 12pm to 4pm.  
Artists' Receptions: Friday, January 17, 5 – 7pm and Friday, April 24, 6 – 8pm. Different artists featured for talk or tours on each evening. Programming could include one or more artist demo workshop(s) sometime during exhibition run, though space for such events is a factor.

*Dates for delivery of artwork:* Friday, January 10, 10am – 4pm, and Saturday, January 11, 10am – 1pm.

*Dates for pickup of artwork:* Wednesday, May 13, 10am – 4pm and Saturday, May 16, 10am – 1pm.

Only works that have been created within the last 3 years AND have not been previously exhibited in any other LMA Show or at the Cedarburg Art Museum will be considered.

Artists should pre-register with LMA on its website using the Juried Exhibit Application Form. All framed artwork is not to exceed 30" in any direction and 2D work needs to be presented with D-rings or picture wire for hanging. Only works that are pre-registered will be accepted on drop-off dates. Artists may pre-register up to two (2) artworks each, but the second work may be subject to space availability by its order of registration. If one of an artist's works does not exceed 16" in any direction, s/he could submit up to three (3) works total.

**Registration deadline: November 30, 2019.** Decisions on space availability for registered entries will be made by CAM curator and LMA exhibition chair 5 – 7 days after the registration deadline.

Cedarburg Art Museum requests 5 or more digital images of artwork that are likely to be in the exhibition by **November 1, 2019.** Early registrants would be ones to have artwork featured. These images will be used in CAM's website promotion, press releases, promo postcards and an outdoor banner.

Artwork may be for sale or Not For Sale (NFS). If work is not for sale, please state a verifiable insurance value on the Entry Form. Sales are encouraged. The Cedarburg Art Museum retains 35% of any sales. Artists will fill out a CAM Consignment Form if work is for sale, or CAM Loan Form if NFS and turn it in at the time of delivery. Forms can be sent electronically to LMA artists in advance or available as a PDF form on LMA website.

After the Cedarburg Art Museum receives LMA artwork, it will be insured by the Museum while it is on Museum premises.
