Tips for early Spring

- Preventative maintenance. Start by servicing your lawn and garden equipment.
- Remove leaves, twigs, and any fallen branches.
- Clean landscape beds and rake your lawn. Be sure to rake lightly so you don't disturb the soil.
- Top dress landscape beds with new mulch
- Apply fertilizer and pre-emergent (crab grass preventative) to your lawn.
- Apply a pre-emergent for weeds to your landscape beds.
- Lay back and watch the beauty of Spring!



Fertilizer & Weed Control

A quality lawn application program not only keeps your lawn looking great but also helps to safeguard your investment. The right program will provide balanced nutrients as well as weed and insect control. A thick, healthy lawn creates a natural resistance to weeds. As stubborn as weeds can be, they will have a much tougher time taking root in thick grass.

We offer 6 lawn applications in total for a complete lawn program. However, the most suitable lawns for 6 rounds of applications are those that are irrigated or are planned to be watered regularly.

Our lawn programs can range from 1 application to 6. Each application has a specific date range for when they should be applied and may vary depending on weather conditions. The 6 lawn applications we offer are:

Round 1 Early Spring - Fertilizer and Pre-emergent (Crab grass preventative)

Round 2 Late Spring – Fertilizer and Weed Control

Round 3 Early Summer – Fertilizer and Weed Control

Round 4 Late Summer – Fertilizer and Weed Control

Round 5 Early Fall – Fertilizer and Weed Control

Round 6 Late Fall – Fertilizer and Weed Control

The lawn program that is most commonly used by our clients consists of 4 applications made up of rounds 1, 2, 4, and 5.
