The Spenser N. Havlick Scholarship program was funded through the generosity of Spenser's sister, Mrs. Lucille Hyatt, and her daughter, Mrs. Lucille Hubbard.

Spenser was in the wholesale building materials business and a member of this Kiwanis Club for over 40 years. Shortly after his death in the 1980's, Mrs. Hyatt decided to create a club memorial on his behalf with the Kiwanis Club of Green Bay. The result was the Green Bay Kiwanis Foundation Inc. and the Spenser N. Havlick Scholarship Fund. Mrs. Hubbard continued donations to the fund after her mother's death and drove from Chicago to attend this dinner for many years. Unfortunately, she passed away in 2015.

Spenser was very interested in education at the college/university level with an emphasis on science and math. That has been the path the scholarship fund has taken. We would like to, once again, acknowledge this outstanding family, with special recognition now to Spenser's son, also named Spenser, who follows the scholarship program from his home in Boulder, Colorado.
