Bowling will be held every Saturday morning at 10 a.m. Cost of bowling is \$6.00 per week, which includes 2 games of bowling, shoes, coaching, parties and prizes all season long. If bowling 3 games cost is \$8.00 per week. A sanction fee of \$15.00 is due the first week of bowling. This sanction fee enables all bowlers to qualify for various prizes and the support of the UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS (USBC).

As a member of a Dome Lanes league, bowlers are also then qualified to bowl at open bowling times at a reduced rate of \$2.25 per game.

- There is **NO SMOKING/ALCOHOL** allowed on the lanes during youth programs.
- There will be **NO RUNNING OR HORSEPLAY** allowed. Children must be up to bowl on their turn or they will receive misses.

The Saturday Strikers Bowling League at Dome Lanes follows the schedule of the Marinette School District. If there is no school on a specific day, there will be no bowling. Also remember that if Marinette Schools are closed due to inclement weather that bowling will also be canceled.

The Halloween Party is just what it says, a party in observance of Halloween. Awards will be given to youth bowlers in costume. Information on Pepsi Tournament, the Child/Adult Christmas Tournament and the In-House Tournament at the end of the year will be announced when the dates are closer. With these extra activities, we hope to make it a more enjoyable time for the youth, while still teaching them the sport of bowling and giving them all a chance to win various awards including scholarships through the Pepsi Challenge event.
