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## **Rockford Town Regular Council Meeting** April 4, 2018 7:00pm

Mayor Roecks called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call took place. Those present were Mayor Carrie Roecks, Councilmembers Clint Stevenson, Micki Harnois, William Benson, Brian Laude, Clerk/Treasurer Heidi Johnson and Public Works' Dave Thompson.

Ms. Harnois made a motion to excuse Councilmember Tim Fricke, due to illness. Mr. Laude seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

Mr. Benson made a motion to approve the amended agenda. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to approve the minutes from the 03/21/2018 regular meeting. Mr. Laude seconded the motion.

Layne Merritt, JUB Engineers, Inc.

Mr. Merritt presented to Council framed pictures of the completed Well #6 project and the Waste Water Treatment Facility (WWTF) project.

Mr. Merritt updated Council with a conversation he had with Gloria Bennett from the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB). Ms. Bennett stated that no money was award to Rockford, nor any other smaller communities, because TIB chose to help fund areas, along with FEMA, that were affected by flooding in 2017.

Ms. Harnois mentioned that she will be in contact with someone at the Department of Health to ask them if they will sign off on the town's Complete Streets plan.

Mr. Merritt talked about his discussion with Cynthia Wall with the Department of Ecology (DOE) regarding updates to the town's NPDES permit. Ms. Wall said she would remove items within the permit that no longer pertain to Rockford's operations.
