Your Theatre at The Highwood Theatre presents Other Desert Cities as part of Highwood's 2014-2015 season

In two weeks, Your Theatre, a division of The Highwood Theatre, will present the family drama *Other Desert Cities* by Jon Robin Baitz. Nominated in 2012 for five Tony Awards including Best Play and a 2012 finalist for the Pulitzer Prize for Drama, *Other Desert Cities* is a gripping story about a family with differing political views, emotional baggage and a dark secret.

When the Wyeth family gather for their first Christmas together in six years, their daughter Brooke announces she is writing a memoir, opening deep wounds that are not easily healed. The family must suffer through uncomfortable conversations, heated political arguments and painful memories to come out on the other side, while Brooke has to decide whether to stay loyal to her family or true to herself. Director Ryan Gunning sums it up, "It's dark and brutal at times, but also funny and real. The audience is forced to sit in a room and witness the darkest parts of a family. It is uncomfortable and awkward and real. That is what makes is so special and so fantastic." The play is a perfect complement to Highwood's 2014-2015 season theme, The Human Network - exploring our stories, emotions, and connections to one another.

Other Desert Cities features the talents of Sue Schaeffel (Polly Wyeth), Bob Chaves (Lyman Wyeth), Melissa Robinson (Silda Grauman) Anna Jackson (Brooke Wyeth) and Tim Torre (Trip Wyeth).
