DESCRIPTION: Norm Richards was a California bowyer who produced high-end recurve target bows during the 1960's, including such models as the Cardinal, Fascination, and Fantastique. His bows are fairly rare and have become collector's items. Nice looking and performing recurve. Robin egg blue face limbs—white back limbs. This is a great bow. However, it has a number of filled screw holes, most of which are only visible from close-up (see pics). Bow has no delamination; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. However, the limbs have a number of scratches and some spotty "yellowing". A few minor scratches and nicks here and there.
