DESCRIPTION: Colt did not make their own bows, but contracted them out. Initially, during the Hartford CT years, the contract went to Bob Lee's Wing Archery. The '63 Huntsman was Colt's top hunting bow, and was priced 30% higher than the Bear Grizzly. Although a short 52" bow, it does not stack at all at my 27" draw length. However, someone with a draw length longer than 28" should avoid this and other short hunting bows. Comfortable grip. Bubinga riser; forest green limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition (I did some repair work to the lower limb tip—see pic on last page). No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are fair condition. I recently tested and shot this bow several times. For an old gal, this is a great looking and performing re-conditioned recurve. Comes with a new string.
