Mayor Carrie Roecks called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM

Vicki Bergstrom was the only citizen to make public comment. She stated that she felt the B Street project should include ditching. She said there was a lot of run off which would cause the road to be washed out over and over.

Councilmember Micki Harnois asked if ditching was not included because outside funding would not pay for that. Mr. Thompson said yes, that was what the newest information was that he was hearing.

There being no further comment Ms. Roecks closed the Public Hearing.
