Responsive Competitive Grant Cycle Description

The Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona is seeking applications for Responsive Competitive grants.

Grant Cycle –April 9th through May 8th, 2018. Awards will be announced by July 23rd, 2018.

Every year the Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona funds Responsive Competitive Grants for projects up to \$5000 that are aligned with the Foundation Mission of Promoting Population Health and Community Wellness.

The Responsive Competitive Grant Cycle is done collaboratively with Arizona Community Foundation-Cochise. Grant workshops and grant timelines are the same. The Legacy Foundation only accepts applications focused on population health and community wellness. Applications are submitted to ACF-Cochise for any other type of project.

The Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona collaboratively with ACF-Cochise will kick off the Responsive Competitive Grant Cycle with a workshop that will provide full information regarding the goals of the cycle.

Funding Request Range

Proposals may be submitted for up to \$5000 per year. Funding will be for one year.

An agency can not apply for funding until all reports required for previous awards have been received.
