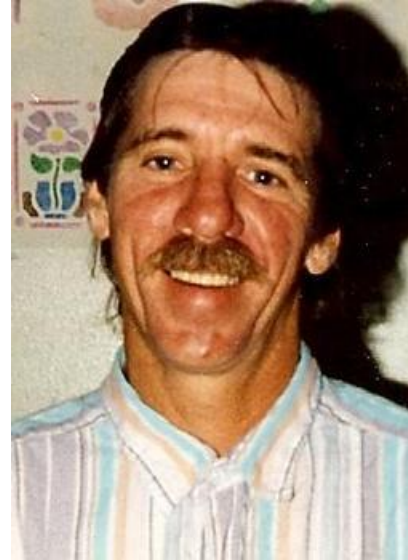


Randy James Dutcher

Randy James Dutcher, 57, of Pigeon died Friday, June 6, 2014 at his home while under hospice care.
