



## Forest Hills Parking Request

1. Parking in Forest Hills is scarce with only a limited amount of curb spots for those residents without driveways for personal parking, as well as for guests and workmen.
2. Unfortunately, some residents with driveways neglect to utilize their driveways at all, even when away for extended periods of time.
3. Please be aware that within the next couple of weeks, construction will begin on the entrance to Queen Street and the berm on Army Navy Drive which will prohibit parking on both sides of the first block of Queen Street for 4 to 6 weeks. **This will compound our existing parking problem!**
4. Residents can assist by using garages, driveways and trying to park in a manner that does not leave "half a parking space" between their car and car in front or behind when parking along the curb.
5. The Arlington County street sweeper is scheduled to be in Forest Hills on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup>. It would be helpful if as few cars as possible were parked on the street on that day. (From past experience, I know that Arlington does not always keep to the schedule but we can hope!)
