- o Acceptance at an accredited college or university or institution of higher education; and
- Documented evidence from the community service advisor of the minimum of 20 hours of community service. (attach: written recommendation(s) from the service advisor).

Subsequent years (data is due no later than July 31st of each year):

- Documented evidence of 20 hours of community service each year;
- o Initially, the applicant must have a 3.0 high school GPA to be eligible for consideration; thereafter, a 2.5 GPA must be maintained.
- Continued eligibility is based upon four consecutive years with no break in schooling (other than summers)
